

Dauphin County to hold Arbor Day tree sale

HARRISBURG — In Day, the Dauphin observance of Arbor County Conservation

District will conduct its annual seedling sale on April 25

During the past seven years, more than 110,000 trees have been purchased by Dauphin

County residents through the Conservation District's seedling sale

Hardwood species for sale are red oak, white flowering dogwood,

white ash, black walnut, scarlet maple and russian olive. Conifers to be sold are douglas fir, blue spruce, white pine and norway spruce. The average size of

the three and four year old bareroot seedlings is 12 inches for conifers and 20 inches for hardwoods

Trees have many benefits, not the least of

which is energy conservation. During the summer months shade trees act as "nature's air-conditioner" and reduce or eliminate the need for mechanical cooling

In the winter trees planted as a windbreak also reduce energy costs. For instance, a row of evergreens 20 feet high can slow down winds for a distance of 200 feet and lower heating bills by up to 20 percent.

The use of firewood as an alternative fuel is yet another benefit of trees. Red oak produces 26 million BTU's per cord, while white ash yields 23 million BTU's per cord.

Other benefits of trees are erosion control, privacy, property beautification, reduction of noise levels, wildlife habitat and, of course, timber production

Black walnut is the top money tree due to its beautiful dark wood
