

Warwick FFA presents awards at annual banquet

BRICKERVILLE — Members and parents went on a film trip to Wyoming at the annual Awards Banquet of the Warwick FFA Chapter in the Brickerville Fire Hall on Thursday, April 2.

Host for the trip was "Smokey" Roberts, well-known Lancaster scuba diver and underwater cinematographer.

Location for the film was Elbow Lake, which is found more than 11,000 feet above sea level in the Teton Mountains of Wyoming. "Star" of the film was Slim Pickens, who has appeared in hundreds of Western films.

While the quest to photograph the California golden trout in Elbow Lake was unsuccessful, the film was filled with breath-taking

mountain scenery and marked the first time that underwater diving at such a high altitude had been attempted and recorded.

Roberts also explained various diving gear to the audience and outlined other diving projects he is conducting.

The initial awards presented at the banquet, attended by approximately 150, included the crowning of the new Chapter Sweetheart, Debra Stauffer, and the presentation of an Honorary Chapter Farmer Degree to Dale Gerber, vo-ag teacher and chapter advisor.

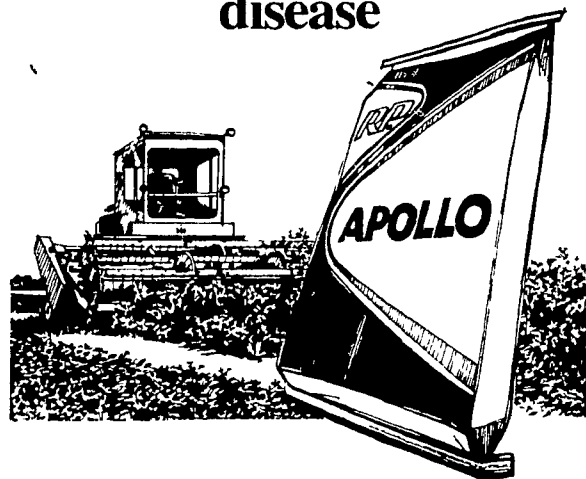

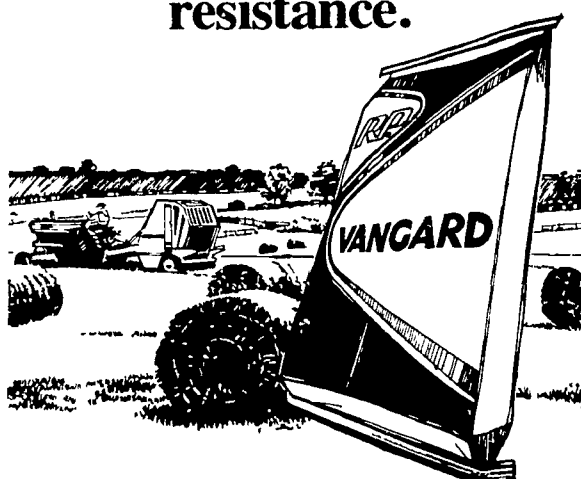
