Mid-Atlantic milk pool limit suspended

NEW YORK, N.Y. - A provision of the Middle Atlantic federal milk marketing order has been suspended by the United States Department of Agriculture.

Herbert L. Forest, dairy official with USDA's Agricultural Marketing Service, said the suspension lifts from March

the type of pool eligible for automatic pool status during that period. Forest said the suspension was requested by Michaels Dairies,

Inc., a distributing plant regulated under the order. Michaels contends that products

through August 1981 the limit on

supplying its plants were threatened with loss of pooling status under the order because the firm has lost Class I sales to another handler in the market.

As a result, Michaels said it would not be able to continue meeting the pooling requirement of the order.

Federal milk marketing orders set minimum prices regulated handlers must pay dairy farmers for their milk. The orders do not set prices consumers pay for milk or dairy products at retail outlets.

N.Y. meat fined

TROY, N.Y. - Wilson Foods Corp., a Troy, N.Y. meat firm, has been fined \$500 for selling adulterated smoked meats.

The fine was imposed by Judge James T Foley in the US. District Court of Albany, N.Y., after Wilson pled guilty to violating the Federal Meat Inspection Act.

Donald L. Houston, Administrator of the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Food Safety and Quality Service, said the violation was discovered in June 1980 after an FSQS compliance officer and a New York State agriculture inspector found approximately 120 pounds of spoiled smoked meats in an Albany supermarket

Houston said the product was voluntarily destroyed by the supermarket

Under the Federal Meat Inspection Act, all meat products prepared and transported for sale in commerce must be wholesome and truthfully labeled.
