

Order 4 milk up to \$15.45 for May

ALEXANDRIA, Va — Middle Atlantic Order Market Administrator Joseph D. Shine last Friday announced a Class I milk price of \$15.45 per hundredweight for May 1981.

This price is up one cent from the April price and is \$1.08 above the May 1980 price.

Order No. 4 prices are announced for milk testing 3.5 percent butterfat, f.o.b. plants located within 55 miles of Philadelphia and also within 75 miles from the

neerer of Washington, DC or Baltimore, MD. There is also a six-cent direct-delivery applicable to producer milk received at plants located within 55 miles of Philadelphia.

Shine announced a Class II milk price of \$12.64 per hundredweight for March 1981 and a butterfat differential of 16.9 cents for the month. The Class II milk price is down six cents from the previous month while the butterfat dif-

These class prices are based on the March 1981 Minnesota-Wisconsin manufacturing milk price of \$12.67 per hundredweight adjusted to a 3.5 percent butterfat content.

The USDA reported that the wholesale price of Grade A butter at Chicago for March was unchanged at \$1.4725 per pound and the nonfat dry milk price was down.

Block to confer with ag leaders

WASHINGTON, DC — Secretary of Agriculture John Block is scheduled to speak at the seventh ministerial session of the World Food Council in Belgrade, Yugoslavia, May 25, and to meet with West European agricultural leaders during a 12-day trip to six countries.

He will leave Washington May 23 and return June 4.

Block will meet with officials of the European Economic Community May 26. At each of his other stops, he will meet with cabinet level officials.

Block will be in The Hague, The Netherlands, June 2 to 4, to open a five-day conference of 31 agricultural counselors and attaches stationed at U.S. embassies throughout Europe, the Near East and Africa.

These meetings will cover trade problems and U.S. objectives in markets that in 1981 will import about \$20 billion in U.S. farm products.
