

Simmental photo contest deadline is June 1

BOZEMAN, Mt. — The American Simmental Association's Second Annual Photo Contest will close June 1, according to Executive Vice President, Earl B. Peterson. "During our first photo contest, 94 individuals submitted 237 photographs for consideration," he said. "We're anticipating even greater participation this time." First prize in the initial contest went to Jaci York of Sultan, Washington, while Wink Lundell of

Granite Falls, Minnesota took second place.

Revised contest rules have established two divisions of competition: Junior, for those 21 and under, and Senior. Seven place winners in each division, or 14 in all, will be recognized, and more than \$600 in prizes will be distributed.

Criteria for judging includes three major factors: ability to favorably represent Simmental

cattle; quality of photography; and eye appeal, human interest and originality.

The announcement of place winners will be made during ASA's Annual Summer Conference, which is scheduled for July 16-19 at Asheville, North Carolina.
