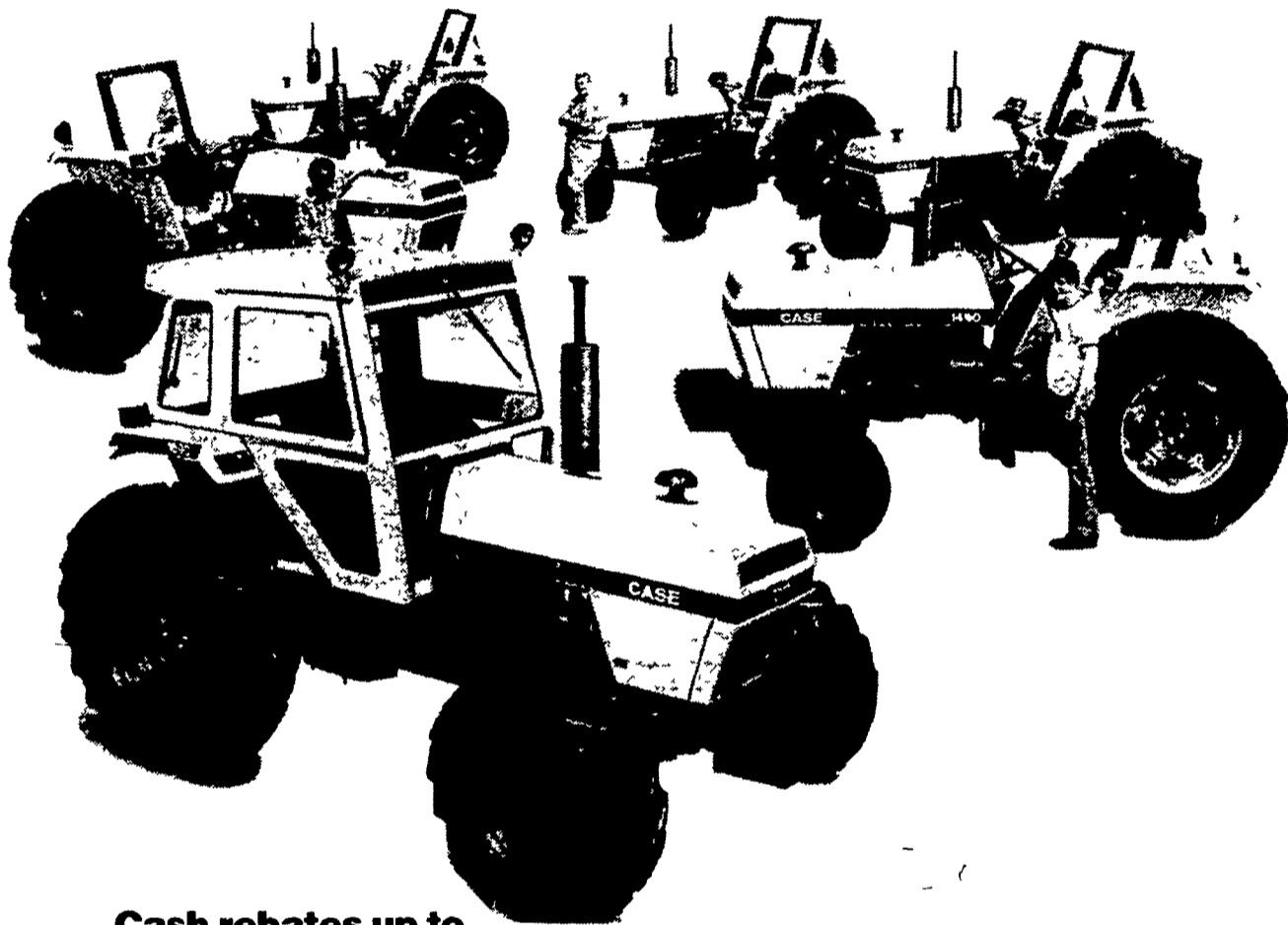

## Delaware state 4-H leader dies

NEWARK, Del. — James O. Baker, Delaware state 4-H leader since 1960, died at home on Sunday, April 12. He will long be remembered by Delaware youth and fellow extension workers for his tireless efforts on behalf of 4-H youth work in the state.

Baker began his 4-H career as a county agent in his native West Virginia in 1950. Eight years later he came to Delaware as Sussex county 4-H agent.

In 1960 he became state 4-H leader. Born in Fairmont, W.Va., he held a B.S. in agriculture from West Virginia University and a M.S. in agricultural economics from the University of Delaware.

Among his many achievements as state leader was the strengthening of the 4-H junior leadership program - a source of some of the state 4-H program's strongest supporters today. Many of these former club members are now volunteer leaders or project leaders for other youth.

One of Baker's most recent achievements was the establishment in 1979 of the Delaware 4-H Foundation.
