amounts but small quantities of certain nutrients to balance out the crop needs," he commented.

When in doubt about the extent of nutrients already available, have the soil tested, Smith advised. The greatest efficiency takes place, he added, when just enough fertilizer is applied to satisfy current nutrient needs

He claimed good responses came with small amounts of fertilizer, in general, at many of the test sites. This included 25 pounds per acre of nitrogen and 60 pounds per acre of phosphate for snappeans and sweet corn banded along the rows. Tomatoes produced their best yields with 50 pounds per acre of nitrogen, 120 pounds per acre of phosphate, and 60 pounds per acre

whole range of plant foods in large of potash also banded along the rows. Potash usually gave good results with tomatoes but not with snapbeans or sweet corn.

"The first small quantities of fertilizer usually give the highest possible response from vegetables," he said. "Our experiments also showed the best results when fertilizer was banded along the rows, instead of being spread over the entire field or garden. With banding you cut your fertilizer use in half, he noted.

Most of the soils tested in the 19 counties were well supplied with potash. This fertilizer is effective in small quantities, it was pointed out. Excess potash, however, restricts uptake of magnesium, as well as calcium and phosphate, and should be avoided.


