First meeting for anyone in-

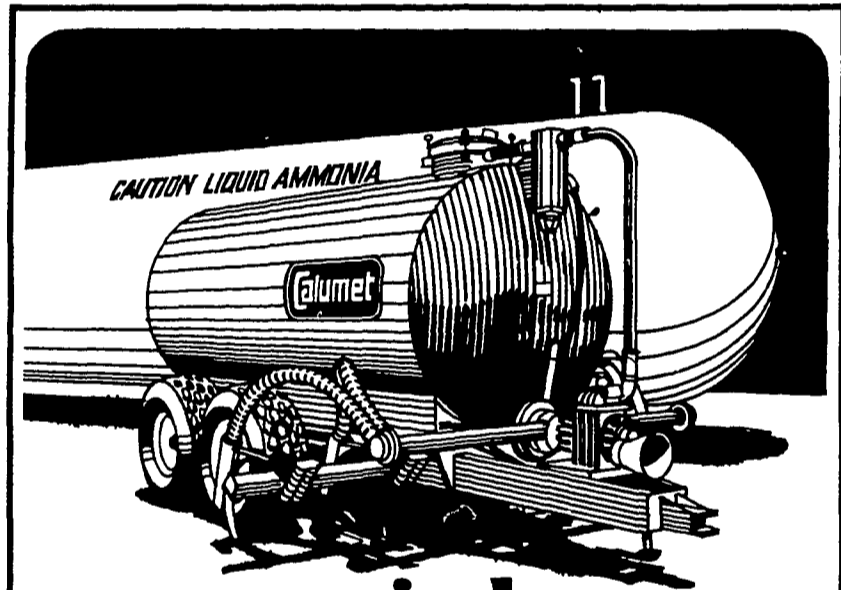
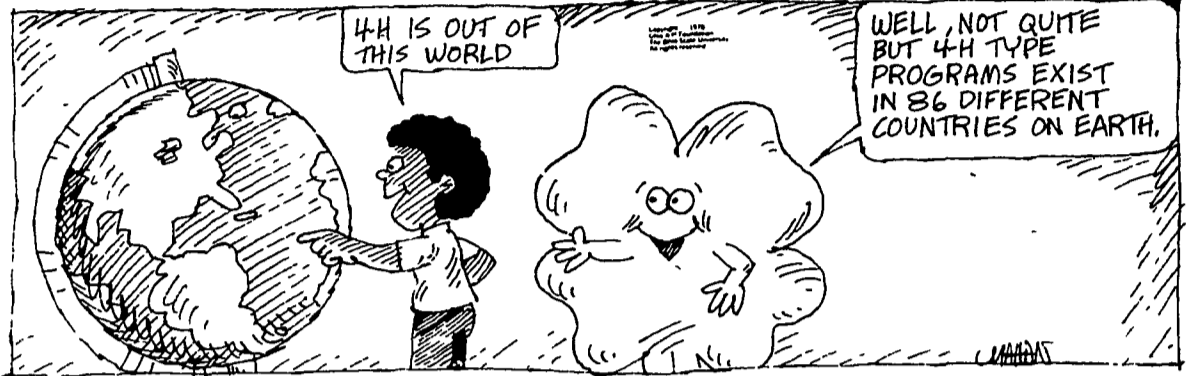
terested in a clowning club is May 28 at 7:30 p.m. at the Extension Office.

The next meeting will be held on June 8, 8 p.m. at Buffington's place. Showman and fitting demonstrations will be presented.

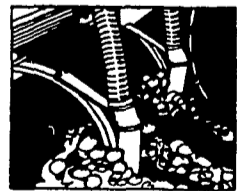
