

Agronomist to chair Congress

UNIVERSITY PARK — Grasslands constitute a major renewable natural resource in the United States and the world.

In many areas of the world, grazing lands provide the greatest underdeveloped resource for increasing food production, especially animal products. Forages also require less fossil fuel to produce animal feed while simultaneously protecting land from the ravages of wind and water erosion.

"In Pennsylvania, about 5 million acres of hay and pasture supply an estimated \$650 million worth of forage to produce meat, milk, and livestock products," says John E. Baylor, professor of agronomy extension at Penn State.

Baylor, an internationally known forage specialist, is currently devoting a major portion of his time serving as chairman of the governing board of the Fourteenth International Grassland Congress scheduled for June 15-24 at the University of Kentucky.

Scientists from 49 countries will present nearly 500 technical papers at the Congress to exchange information to provide the world agricultural community incentives to increase forage production, human nutrition, and conservation of land and water resources.

"The potential benefits to mankind that can come from the worldwide exchange of information are beyond the imagination," the Penn State agronomist notes. "Attendance estimates vary from 1,000 to 1,500 persons, representing about 60 countries."

The Congress focus is on assuring the grazing and harvested forage supplies needed to feed the world's 2.8 billion ruminant animals that supply nearly all of the milk and nearly one-half of the meat consumed in the world.

Authorities estimate increases in the world's population and con-

sumer buying power will create a demand for 74 percent more milk, 82 percent more beef, and 90 percent more sheep and goat meat in the next 20 years.

"This is only the second time this prestigious event had been held in the United States. Previously, the Congress was held in

Pennsylvania in 1952," the Extension Service agronomist emphasizes.

Tours scheduled before and after the Congress include trips to several areas of the United States, including Pennsylvania, and Canada, as well as shorter field trips to outstanding forage-livestock farms and points

of interest in Kentucky.

A Mid-Congress "Forage Producers Forum" on June 19 and field trips on June 20-21 will be of special interest to Pennsylvania grassland farmers. Kentucky field trips will take visitors to local university agronomy, beef, dairy, and horse farms in the state.
