Wismer joins Penn State's Board of Trustees

HARRISBURG — Charles E. Wismer, Jr., Master of the Pennsylvania State Grange, was elected to Penn State's Board of Trustees for a three-year term, effective July 1.

Wismer was elected to the 32member Board by representatives from agricultural societies in each county. The Board of Trustees serves as the supreme governing body of the university, and A State Grange Master has served as agricultural representative on the board for many years.

Wismer is a dairy farmer from Montgomery County and has headed the 44,000-member State Grange organization since 1979. In addition to his work for the Grange, he is very active in his hometown community of Trappe, serving as mayor of the borough for the past four years, president of the Trappe Historical Society and chairman of the Borough Planning Commission.

His agriculture committee involvement has included 11 years as Community Committeeman for the Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service and three years as Agway Community Committeeman. More recently, Wismer was appointed to the board

of overseers for University of Pennylvania's School of Veterinary Medicine. "I consider it an honor to serve on Penn State's Board of Trustees," Wismer commented.
