Slaughter bulls near steady early in the week with few sales late, weak undertone noted; yield grade 1-2 1000-1600 lbs. 49.25-53.00 early; two head 1900-2000 lb. at 52.00 late. Salable receipts this week totaled near 17,100 head compared with 16,638 head last week. Feeder cattle and calves made 94% of the supplies while cows & bulls make 6%.

Declines in early trading were fully recouped by mid session as dressed trade improved and salable receipts remained moderate. The percentage of yield grade 1-5 Steers and Heifers continues to decrease while the number of Heifers weighing 875-950 lbs. is on the upswing. The overall finish on Steers showed average Choice, while many consignments of Heifers carrying noticeable percentage of good grades. Demand by most interests good throughout session.

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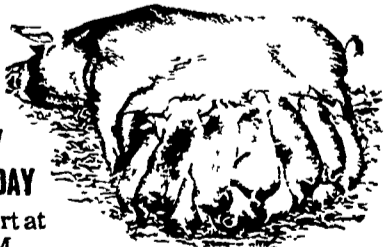
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
