### USDA issues 1981 loan and purchase rates

mers now can receive federal loan production trends and, for some and purchase rates for 1981-crop grain and soybeans for their individual county, according to an official of the U.S. Department of

Agriculture.

Everett Rank, administrator of USDA's Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Services, said copies of the rates have been sent to state and county ASCS offices and also are available from the price support and loan division, USDA-ASCS, P.O. Box 2415, Washington, D.C., 20013.

Rank said county rates are based on a national average rate for each crop and vary from county to county to reflect dif-

ferences in the value of the crop, commodities, transportation costs to terminal points. The national rates were announced earlier.

He said some minor adjustments have been made from the 1980 rates to reflect slight changes in area-to-area relationships and he urged farmers to check with their county ASCS office to see whether their county rates have been affected.

USDA commodity loans give producers an opportunity to obtain cash while holding their crop for later sale. By holding a crop, producers minimize market gluts,. extreme price swings and transportation bottlenecks.


