

Dairy dessert winner announced

CAMP HILL — Frances E. Dietz of York was named the first prize winner in the Dairy Dessert Contest held Saturday, June 6, at the Capital City Mall.

The contest was held in conjunction with the Pennsylvania Agriculture Products Promotion Days sponsored by the Capital City Mall promotions department and the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture.

Dietz's winning entry from 23 contestants was "Francie's Double Chocolate Torte," featuring devil's food cake, Pennsylvania eggs, heavy cream, sour cream, chocolate and raisins. Dietz was awarded a \$50 gift certificate from Hess's Department Store. Her

recipe will also be featured in the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture's 1982 Commodity Calendar for June which is Dairy Month.

Winning second place and a \$25 gift certificate from Kinney Shoes was Mart Hall Miller of Carlisle. Miller's recipe, "Butter Horns," featured butter, sour cream, eggs and vanilla with a topping of egg whites, sugar, vanilla and grated nuts.

"Pineapple Snow," which can be served as either a dessert or a side dish for a main meal, was the third place winner for Carol Rentschler of Carlisle. Rentschler received a \$25 gift certificate from Music Fair for her entry.

Judging the contest were Mildred Bowers, food editor for the Patriot News; Debbie Keys, Manager of Hess's Department Store; and Myrna Kippler, Cumberland County Home Economist.

State Representative John Kennedy of the 88th District in Cumberland County assisted Deputy Agriculture Secretary E. Chester Heim in presenting the awards to the winners.

State Honey Queen Becky Fisher, Apple Queen Heather Staubach, Pork King Joseph Sheffer and Cumberland County Dairy Princess Sharon Cornman

were also on hand to distribute samples of their products.

"Mall shoppers had an opportunity to see the wide variety of quality food products that are grown and packaged in Pennsylvania," Hallowell said. "The consumer can easily see that by simply looking for the 'We're Growing Better' logo when shopping, they are helping themselves to a quality product."

The following is the top dairy dessert contest winning recipe:

FRANCIE'S DOUBLE CHOCOLATE TORTE
1 (18.5 oz.) Devil's Food Cake Mix (not pudding type)

2 large eggs
2 cups heavy cream

Mix cake according to package directions, using above ingredients instead of those listed on package. Bake in two greased and floured nine-inch pans as directed on package. Split each into layers (easier if cake is frozen).

Make filling by combining:
6 oz. chocolate morsels, melted
1 cup sour cream
1 teaspoon vanilla
1/2 cup chopped raisins plumped in 1 tablespoon rum
Spread between and on top of layers. Better if served the second day.

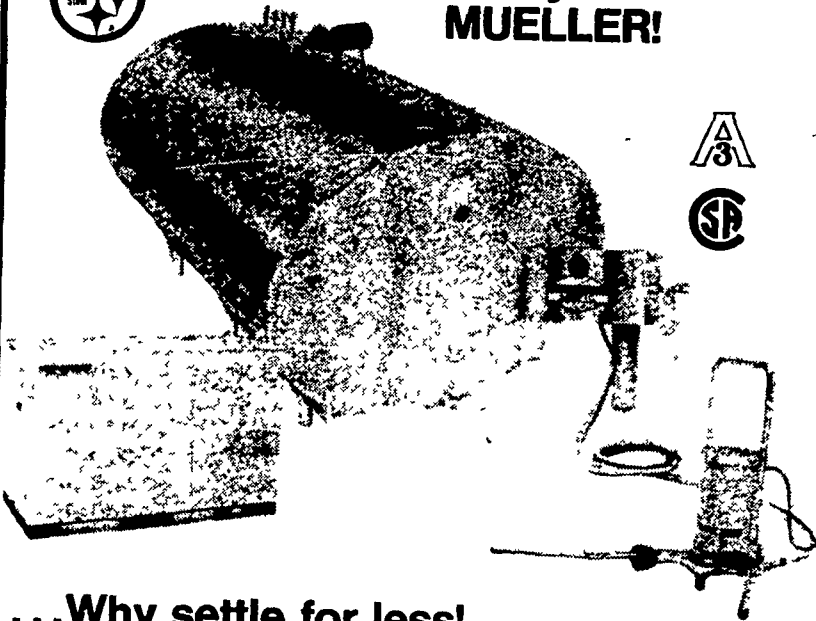

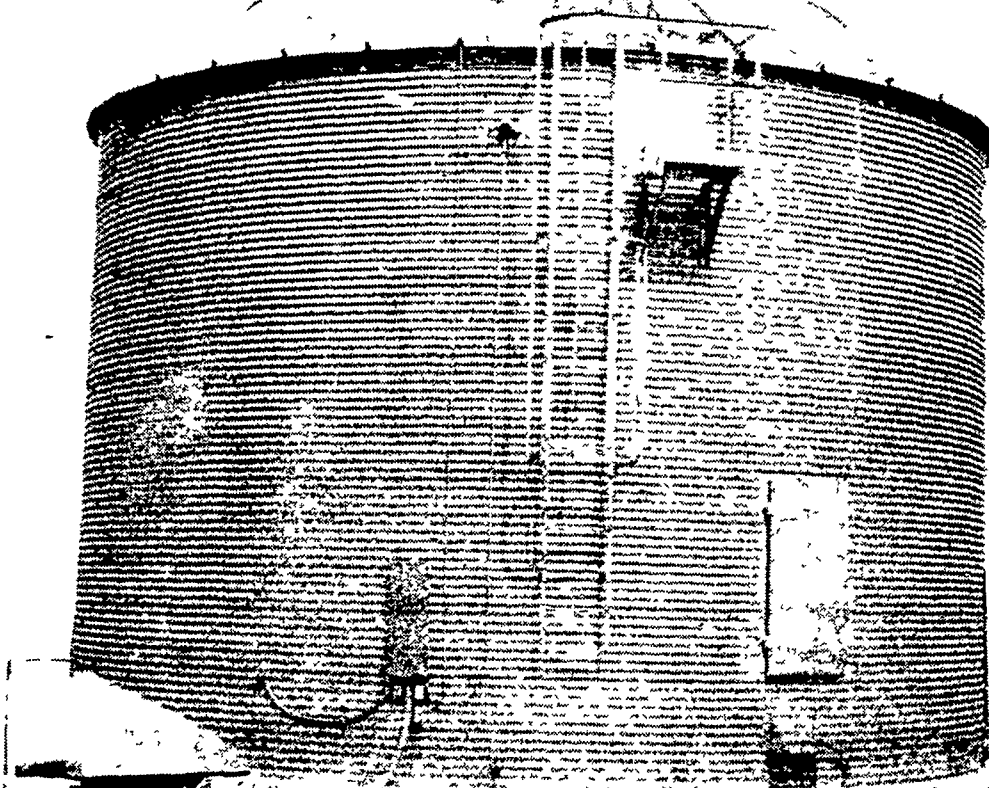
