

Swartz pen tops market hog show, sale

LANCASTER — The Grand Champion Pen of 10 brought \$60.00 a hundredweight at the annual Market Hog Show and Sale Wednesday at the Lancaster Stockyards.

Coming out of the mediumweight class, the pen was consigned by Robert Swartz, R1, Thompsontown, Juniata County, through Walter M. Dunlap and Sons and

purchased by Leidy Packing.

The grand champion pen averaged 228 lbs. The pen was purchased as feeder pigs at the Stockyards, which is believed to be a first in the history of the show and sale.

The Reserve Champion Pen, consigned by Franklin Feeser, of Tanneytown, Md., was sold for \$56.00 to John Snyder. Also con-

signed through Dunlap, the heavyweights averaged 231 lbs.

Average for the sale was 54.82, including the champions. Average weight was 219 lbs.

In all, 190 hogs in pens of 10 each were judged by Henry Gruber, of A and B Packing.

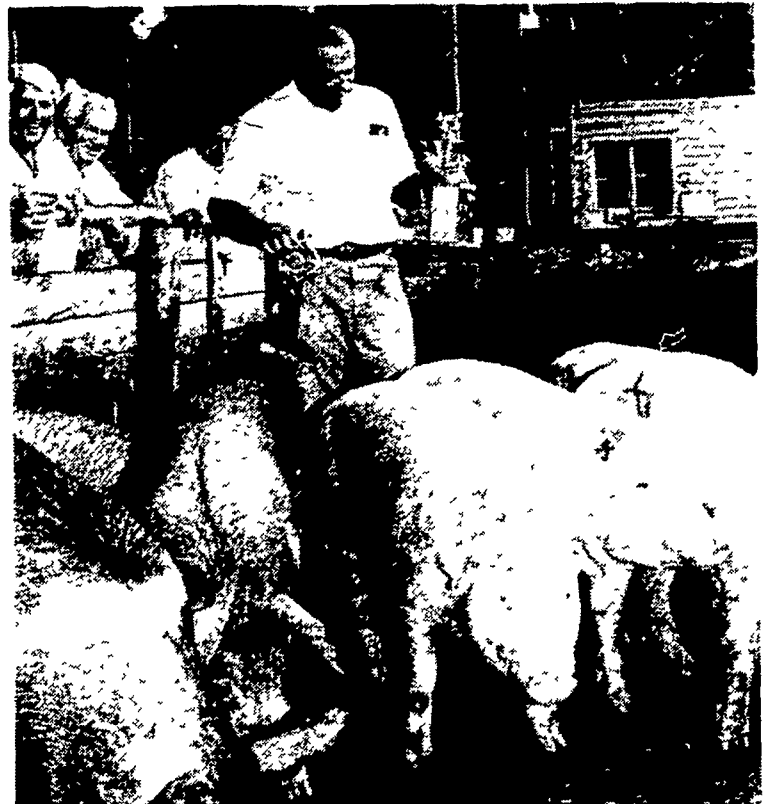
