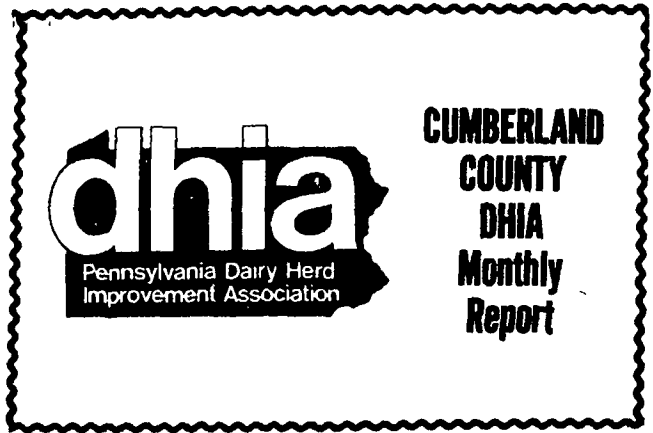

Cumberland County DHIA Herd Improvement records show that 8409.1 cows in 140 herds were on production testing in May according to Duane G. Duncan, County Agent. Of the 117 herds of DHIA, 77 herds had an average fat production of 1.50 pounds per cow per day for the month. During the month 156 completed their 305 day lactation with 600 lbs. of butterfat. DHIA Supervisors working with the dairymen to improve efficiency include Harold Boldosser, 130 Old Gap Road, Carlisle, Paul Wynn, RD #1, Box 88, Newburg; Jay Zeigler, RD #1, Carlisle; and John Rolar, RD #2, Newville.
