Four Day Receipts 9961, Last Week 12,881, Year Ago 13,168. Steers made up 47 pct. of week's receipts, heifers 35 pct., cows 10 pct., feeders 6 pct.

Despite sharp declines in the dressed beef trade live cattle prices ranged only nominally lower; as buyers forced to fill near term slaughter needs from salable receipts numbering 21 pct. fewer than last week. The character of the receipts remained consistent with recent sessions, as 1050 lb. and down steers and 950 lb. and down heifers, carrying large percentages of good grades, present in increased numbers; thus best demand again focused on
