In fact, Nissley Vineyards is the first winery in Lancaster County to produce these wines.

All of the Nissley wines will be available to enjoy with picnic producing and storing the Nissley - snacks prepared and served by the

Haldeman Mansion Preservation Society. Also, homemade root beer and lemonade will be available to quench the thirsts of persons under




Rhythms and Wine Sunday" will be applied toward continuing renovations of the Haldeman Mansion in Locust Grove.


