More park land open to hunting

HARRISBURG — An additional 1,854 acres of Pennsylvania State Park land will be open to public hunting this year. The Bureau of State Parks has informed the Game Commission that

additional public hunting acreage is being made available in eight state parks.

State Parks and additional hunting acreages include Locust Lake, 445 acres; Gifford Pinchot, 53 acres; Shawnee, 22 acres; Laurel Hill, 306 acres; Lyman Run, 148 acres; Colton Point, 52 acres; Tuscarora, 756 acres; and Parker Dam, 72 acres.

The additional public hunting acreages in Locust Lake and Tuscarora State Parks will be open only to archery deer hunting in

the fall season and during the archery and flintlock muzzleloader deer season in late December and early January.
