

Record numbers show Angus heifers at nat'l show

NASHVILLE, Tn. — Young Angus breeders brought 604 head of Angus heifers to the 1981 National Junior Angus Heifer Show in Nashville, Tennessee, July 9-10, making it the largest single-breed heifer show ever held, reports Jerry Lipsey, director of Junior Activities for the American Angus Association. The event held here at the Tennessee State Fairground, was judged by Bill Jacobs of California Polytechnic College, San Luis Obispo.

For grand champion Jacobs selected the champion heifer of the bred-and-owned division shown by Rick Blanchard, Mendota, California. The heifer, Ricks Juanadabury 3000, is a daughter of

Sayre Patriot, calved March 3, 1980. The heifer was yearling champion and then champion of the 141-head bred-and-owned division.

Dennis Knop, Ida Grove, Iowa, showed the reserve grand champion heifer, KAF Miss Wampum 037. His heifer was yearling champion and then division champion of the "Owned" division. Born March 5, 1980, the heifer is a daughter of Sir Wms Wampum.

In the special cow-calf division, sponsored by the Tennessee Junior Angus Association, the champion was exhibited by James Pipkin, Springfield, Missouri. The cow was Clearwater Sporty Eriskay J, the

reserve grand champion of the bred-and-owned division at last year's show in Wichita. She had an estimated breeding value ratio for weaning weight of 107, a maternal ratio of 106 and a yearling ratio of 110. She had a heifer calf at side.

Reserve champion of this division was shown by Guy Lewis Laflin, Olsburg, Kansas. The cows breeding value ratios were 101 for weaning weight, 101 for maternal traits, and 102 for yearling weight. She had a bull calf at side.

Reserve yearling and reserve bred-and-owned division champion was shown by Stacia Ellis,

Greentown, Indiana. Her heifer is Stewart's Miss Emulous 650M. Stacia also was named outstanding participant in this year's National Show by the American Angus Auxiliary.

Other bred-and-owned champions included: Intermediate Champion, VL Lady Masterpiece 022, shown by J. Scott Lickteig, Lawrence, Kansas; Reserve Intermediate Champion, Dameron Lass 093, shown by Christy Dameron, Lexington, Illinois; Calf Champion, DD Miss Karama, shown by Todd Dawes, Urbana,

Indiana; and Reserve Calf Champion, Day Dream Esthonia 190, shown by Katy Pat Dunn, Somerville, Tennessee.

Reserve champion heifer of the owned division was the intermediate champion shown by Kevin Resser, LeRoy, Illinois. The heifer is Power Lady 033.

Other champions in the owned division included: Reserve Yearling Champion, ZAF Miss Marshall 36 120, shown by Eric Zehr, Flanagan, Illinois; Reserve

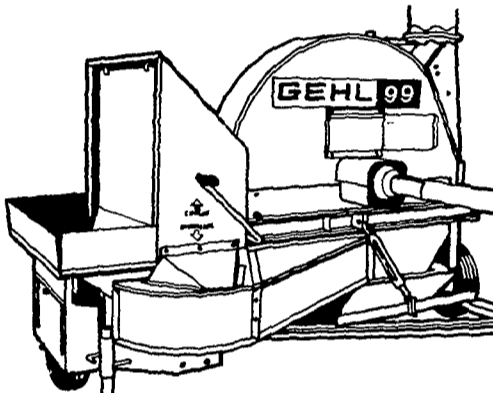

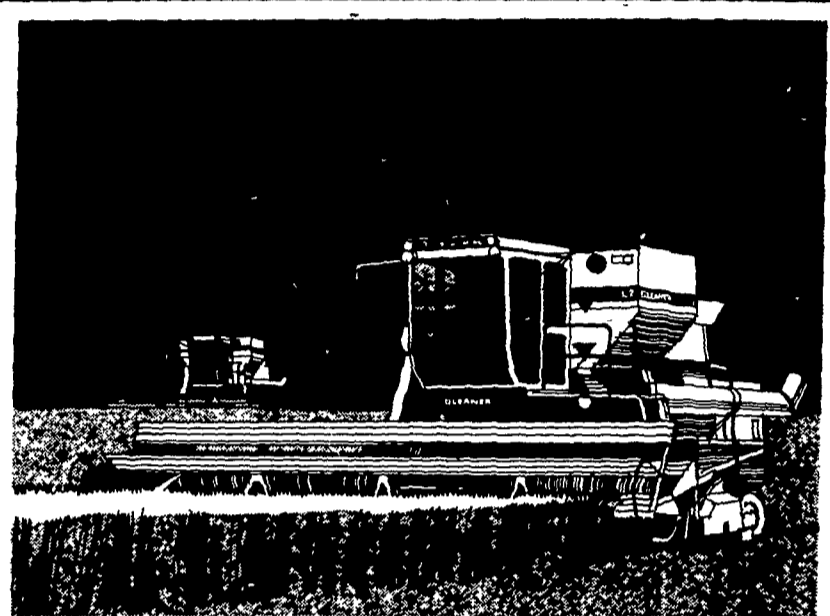
