Sue Swartz, a ten-year member of the Hanover club, fashioned an all-white uniform that she will be using after she completes her training as a radiologic

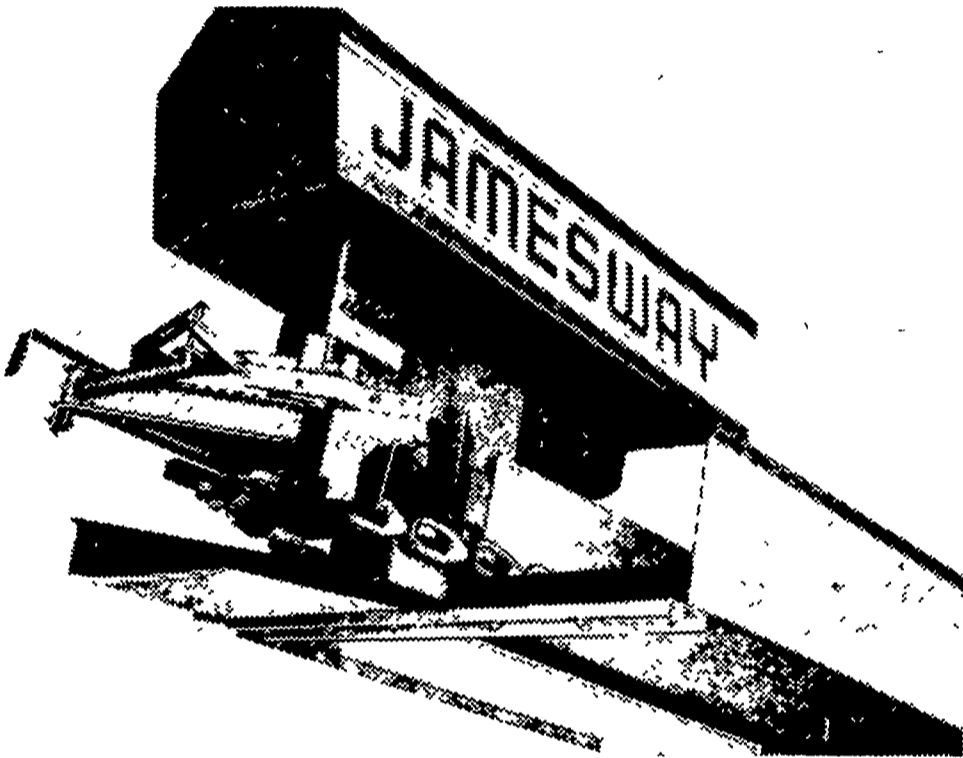
