

# Lancaster County DHIA Monthly Report

A Holstein cow owned by Jonas O. Sensenig, R #1 Holtwood, completed the highest 305 day lactation. 17 produced 20,905 lbs of milk, 979 lbs of butterfat with a 4.7% test. Second high lactation was completed by a Registered Guernsey cow owned by Cedar Fringed Farm, R #1, Peach Bottom. Junella produced 17,013 lbs of milk, 978 lbs of butterfat with a 5.7% test in 305 days.

The herd of John S. Nolt, R #1, New Holland, had the highest daily butterfat average. This herd of 37 Registered & Grade Holstein cows averaged 57.5 lbs of milk, 2.28 lbs of butterfat with a 4.0% test. The herd of Daniel M. Stoltzfus, R #1, Morgantown, placed second. This herd of 53 Registered & Grade Holstein cows averaged 57.1 lbs of milk, 2.26 lbs of butterfat with a 4.0% test.

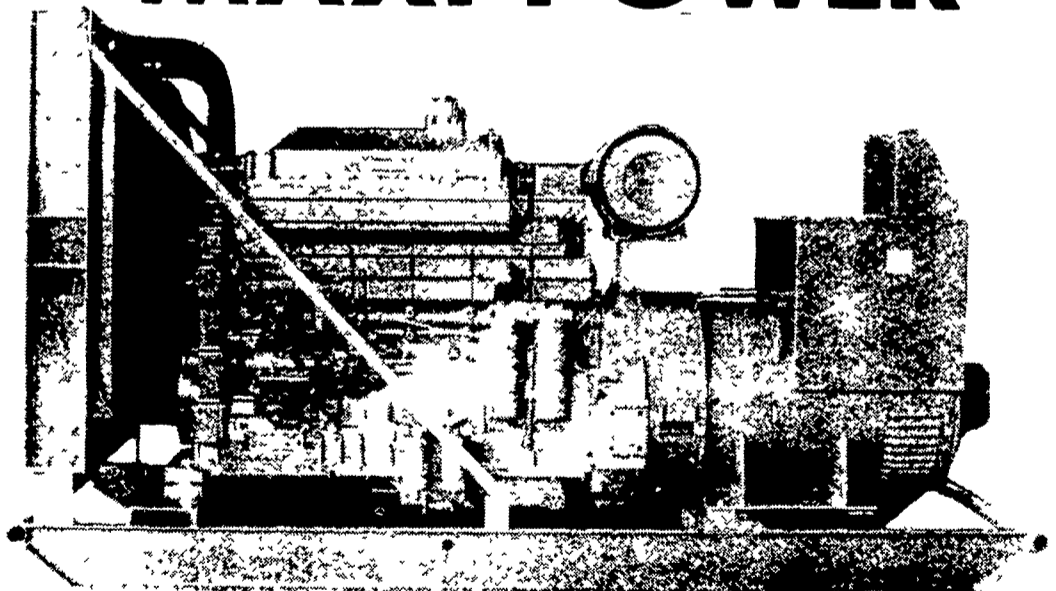

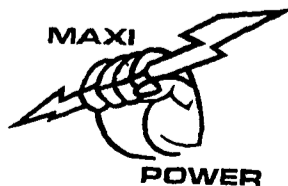
