plications; and for selection of fellowship recipient.

The fellowship recipient will be selected in accordance with the purpose established by the National Porkettes and agreed upon by both the National Porkettes and the Foundation.

The donations to the fellowship qualifies as a non-profit tax exempt organization. Donors will receive a receipt for tax purposes.

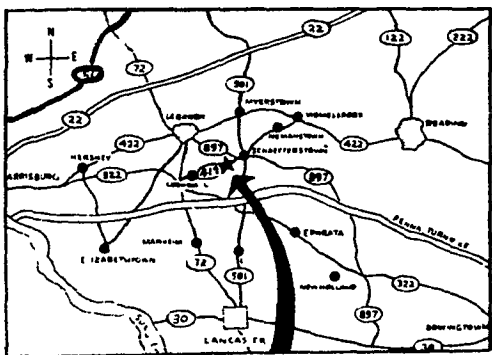

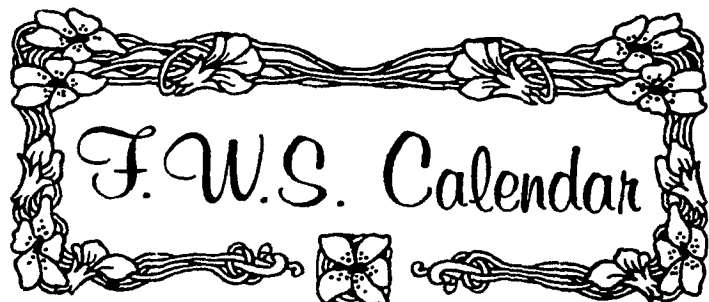
