

Del. marketing specialist forecasts uncertain grain outlook

NEWARK, Del. — "Farmers may want to hold up on further grain sales until the fate of this year's corn and soybean crops is determined," says University of Delaware Extension crops marketing specialist Carl German.

Conditions a month ago indicated a record corn crop, but the picture has changed a lot since then.

"We don't have a definitive new crop production estimate yet on corn," he says, "but you can ex-

pect a considerable reduction in the size of the estimated yield in the next report."

Soybean yields may also be somewhat reduced, but it's too soon to look for substantial reductions in this crop. Rain could still benefit this more drought-resistant crop, says the specialist.

According to estimates of the Delaware-Maryland Crop Reporting Service, Delaware farmers planted about 196,000 acres of corn - 188,000 acres of this

tor grain. This is about 2 percent higher than last year. They planted about 265,000 acres of soybeans.

The June 26 grain stocks report indicates corn supplies of 637,000 bushels stored on Delaware farms as of June 1 - 21 percent below the year-earlier level of 800,000 bushels. Off-farm corn stocks amounted to 2.76 million bushels - 16 percent below last year.

The same report indicates 364,000 bushels of soybeans in storage on Delaware farms - 45

percent below last year's level of 660,000 bushels.

"All of this suggests holding back on further sales right now," German says.

German says he thinks the national corn crop forecast of 7-1/2 billion bushels may be somewhat optimistic due in large part to the lateness of planting in the eastern

part of the Corn Belt this year. The national soybean crop for 1981 is estimated roughly at 2 billion bushels, based on acreage planted.

Farmers should have a better idea of the supply situation on the Eastern Shore when the next Delaware-Maryland Crop Report comes out. It is scheduled for release August 9 or 10.
