

## 22 enter 4-H round-up

PINE GROVE — The 1981 4-H Schuylkill County Dairy Round-Up was held Saturday, August 1 at Jersey Acres, R2, Pine Grove.

Twenty-two county 4-H'ers participated in the show which was judged by Dave Douglass, herdsman, at Delaware Valley College.

In the Guernsey breed competition, Carl D. Miller, R3, Pamaqua, won the Grand Champion and Senior Champion awards with his cow, Bonnie. The Reserve Grand Champion and Junior Champion was awarded to Ryan Kahler, Pitman, and his junior calf, Tina.

Allen Daubert, R2, Pine Grove, and his cow, Eileen, captured the Grand Champion and Senior Champion trophies for the Brown Swiss breed. Daubert also showed the Reserve Junior Champion, a senior calf named Ellen. Reserve Grand Champion and Reserve Senior Champion went to Rick Daubert and his senior two-year-old, Lois. His senior yearling,

Spindle, was selected as the Swiss Junior Champion.

Although the Holstein class competition was very strong, Tracy Snyder, Pitman, managed to capture both the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion awards with his four-year-old, Flu, the Senior Champion and his Junior two-year-old, Farrah, the Reserve Senior Champion.

The Holstein Junior Champion award went to Mark Snyder, Pitman, for his Junior Yearling, Prella. Mike Snyder, showed the Reserve Junior Champion, a senior calf named Poppy.

The stilt Jersey breed competition saw Kent Hettner, R2, Pine Grove, showing the Grand Champion and Senior Champion, a four-year-old named April. Kelly Newswanger's entry, an aged cow named Deer, took home the Reserve Grand Champion and Reserve Senior Champion ribbons.

The Junior Champion award

went to Bruce Rhein for his Junior Yearling, Lovergirl. Karl Hettner showed the Reserve Junior Champion, an intermediate calf named Peaches.

A special award was given to Kristin Hettner, R2, Pine Grove, for submitting the winning drawing in the show book cover

design contest. Honorable mention awards went to Nelson Moyer, R1, Schuylkill Haven, and to Karin Hettner, R2, Pine Grove.

The Senior Showmanship Trophy went to Kent Hettner while Karin Hettner captured the Junior Division award.

Tracy Snyder won the senior

division of the fitting competition and Robert Reed won the junior division.

The county 4-H dairy show winners will qualify to go on to compete in the Southeast District 4-H Dairy Show to be held September 1, at the Allentown Fair.

## Fair features Arabian horses

GAITHERSBURG, Md. — The Montgomery County fair will feature an Arabian Horse Show at the fairground near Gaithersburg on Sunday, August 23, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The show will consist of 45 classes — 22 breeding classes and 23 performance classes (Western, English, Park, Trail, Equitation, Driving and Native Costumes).

Exhibitors are eligible for Legion Merit Points, National

Championship Classes and Blue Ridge High Point Awards.

The following prize monies will be awarded for the winner in each class: \$750 for Purebred; \$500 for Halfbred; and \$300 for Junior Division. Contestants will also compete in special Costume Classes.

The Arabian horse is the oldest registered breed of horses, says Anne Sturm, Show Secretary.

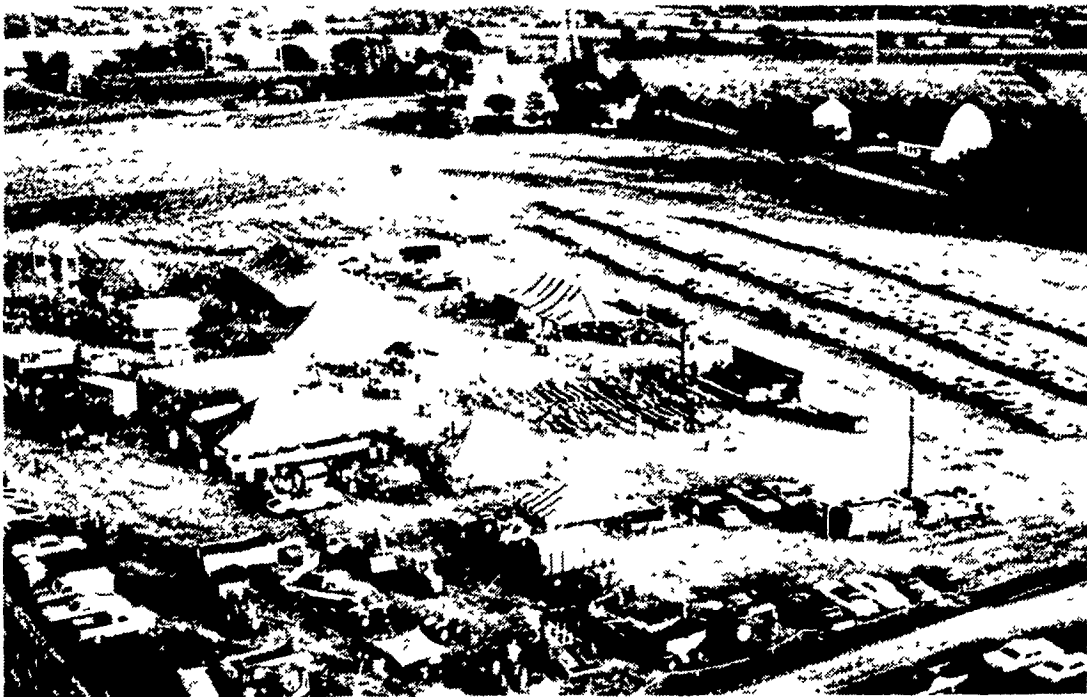
