

## Bradford-Sullivan energy group organizes

WYSOX — The Bradford-Sullivan County Energy Group will officially organize this Tuesday at 8 p.m. at the Wysox Presbyterian Church. Attorney Paul Mazza will be present to begin preparing lease agreements for all group members.

The meeting was planned by the Bradford-Sullivan County Energy Group steering committee, comprised of 14 men and women from all sections of the two counties.

Appointed by the board of the Bradford-Sullivan County Farmers Association, the committee members say they unanimously believe the standard oil and gas

lease presently being offered by leasing companies in the area is far from adequate to protect their land. The committee is dedicated to counteract the power of the leasing companies and is asking people to join in a group effort to withhold land from leasing until better monetary and non-monetary lease terms can be negotiated with the leasing companies through Attorney Mazza.

The energy group concept was initiated by Mazza, lawyer for the Pennsylvania Farmers Association Legal Service, early in the year and the movement has spread throughout the state within

the county organizations of PFA. Mazza has already been successful in some counties gaining better leasing agreements.

Under the leadership of Gary Green, chairman, of Bradford-Sullivan Steering Committee determined the September 8 meeting will be specifically for those landowners who intend to join the group. Anyone who wishes

to join the group, but cannot attend the meeting is asked to contact their area committeeman.

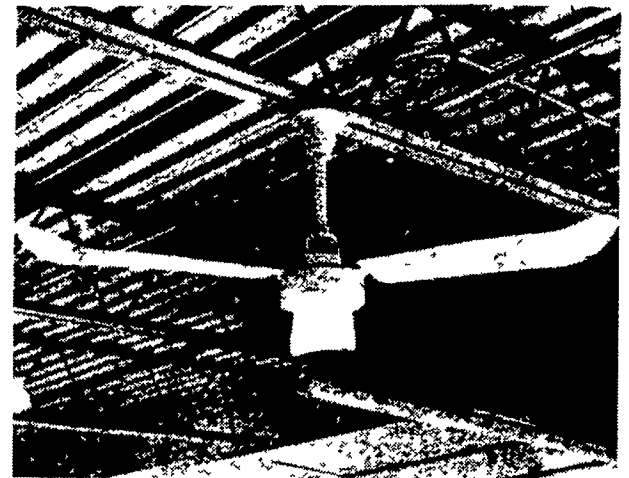
