

## Burkholder shows top hog

CHAMBERSBURG — The 39th Annual Franklin County 4-H Pig Club Show and Sale was held Thursday, August 13, at the Chambersburg, Livestock Market with 78 Market Swine shown and

sold, averaging \$67.26 per hundredweight, announced County Agent Bill Reagan.

The Grand Champion, a 212 lb. Hampshire was shown by Loren Burkholder, Chambersburg, and

was purchased by Hatfield Packing Co., Hatfield, Pa., for the Outstanding price of \$2.49 per lb.

The Reserve Champion, a 244 lb. Duroc shown by Donald Sheiss, Chambersburg, was purchased by W.R. Sellers Livestock Co., Greencastle, for \$1.55 per lb.

In the Pen-of-three classes, the

Grand Champion pen was shown by Eric Sheiss, Chambersburg. The three Durocs averaged 217 lbs. and were also purchased by W.R. Sellers for \$1.11 per pound.

The Reserve Champion Pen-of-three Durocs averaged 228 pounds and were shown by John Amsley, Chambersburg, and purchased by Hatfield Packing Co. for .80 cents per lb.

Champion Showman honors went to Jere Wingert, St. Thomas,

for the 5th consecutive year. Reserve Champion Showman honors went to Greg Christman, Chambersburg.

Thirty-nine 4-H members showed 78 head of market pigs that averaged 212 lbs., and selling for an average of \$69.56 including champions. The sale represents 16,750 pounds of pork-on-the-hoof, valued at \$11,681.80.

**HERE'S HOW IT WORKS...**

As wet grain enters the top of the bin, it flows into the upper drying chamber as harvested with no need for a wet holding bin. This upper chamber holds up to 4 feet of wet grain (2250 bushels).

Every seven minutes a continuous flow auger makes a complete revolution around the upper drying floor drawing the dried grain into the lower cooling area.

Hot air is introduced under the upper floor to dry the wet grain and to heat the surface of the grain that is distributed into the lower cooling chamber. The air that is used for cooling the grain picks up heat during the cooling process. This heated air is then used again in the drying process, saving on fuel costs.

When not being used for drying the bin will store 8500 bushels of grain.
