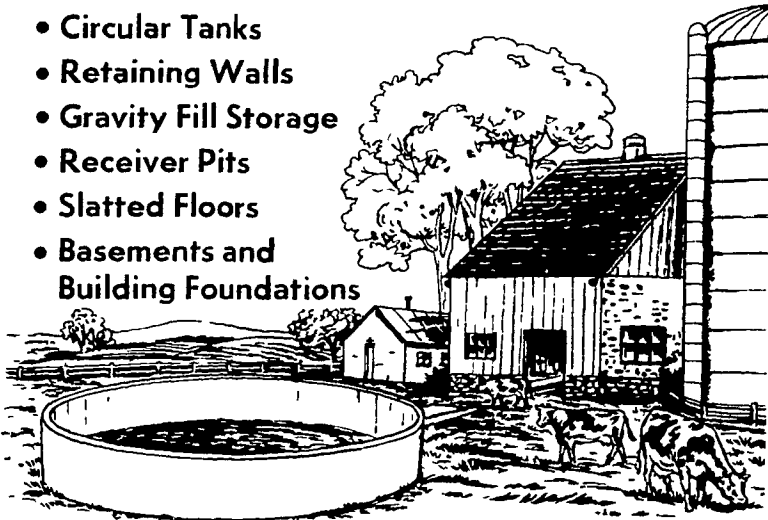

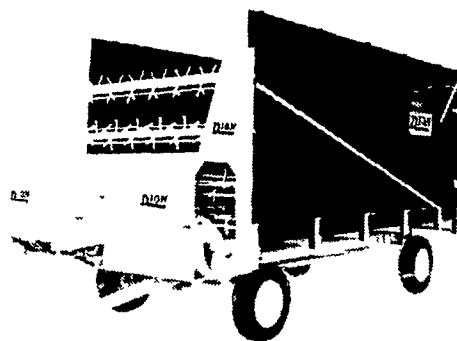

Model 7'x16'x16', three beaters capacity 670 cubic feet. This illustration shows a left hand side delivery.

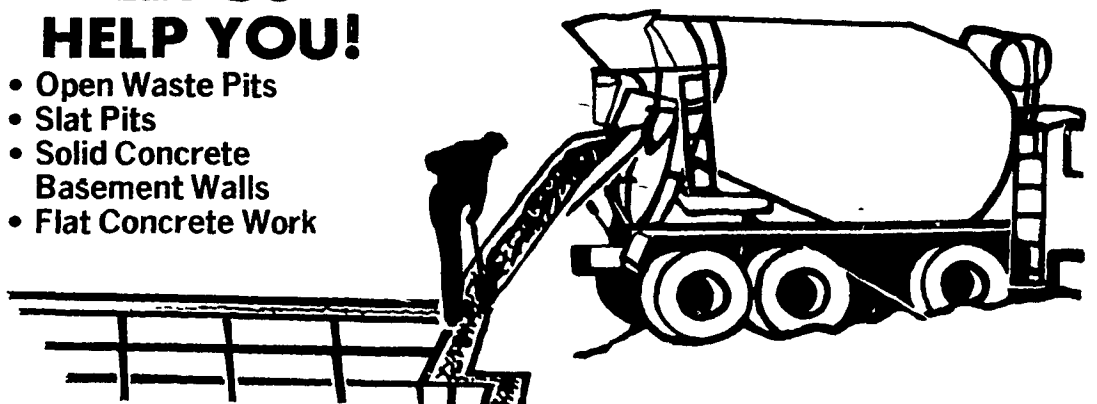
