It was quite foggy and so the ride up the mountain was not as thrilling as it otherwise would have been. The last leg of the trip was in a cog railroad built in 1871, followed by a short steep hike to the peak. After a half-hour, the clouds cleared and we could see snow covered mountains nearby. It was 43 degrees and some farm buildings up there were built in 1604. Brown Swiss cows were pasturing at 6000 ft.

We got our bus at Vitznau and traveled to a ferry where we crossed 500 feet deep Lake Lucerne.

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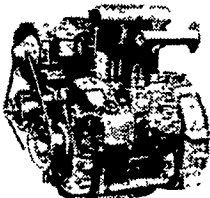
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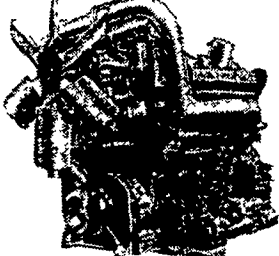


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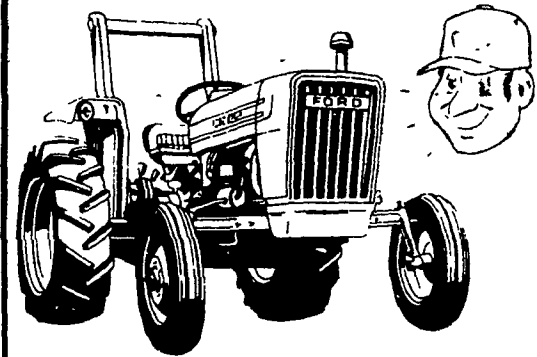


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
