# Hannawald is SCS agronomist

COLLEGE PARK, Md — James Hannawald, 38, has been appointed conservation agronomist for the USDA's Soil Conservation Service serving Maryland, Delaware and New Jersey.

Hannawald will be responsible for overseeing the SCS plant materials program, providing technical assistance to their field offices and for reviewing environmental assessments and impact statements. He will be

stationed here.

Formerly SCS district conservationist for Caroline County, Hannawald earned a bachelor's degree in agronomy from the University of Maryland in 1968. Born in Missouri, he grew up in Prince Georges County, MD. His interest in agriculture started as a youngster when he worked summers on relatives' farms in Missouri.

He worked for six years on

herbicide research for turf and forage crops at the USDA's Agricultural Research Center in Beltsville while attending the university. After graduation he worked with their air pollution research group for about six months.

In July 1968, he joined SCS as a soil conservationist in Harford County. He also served in that capacity in St. Mary's and Caroline Counties before becoming district conservationist in 1973.

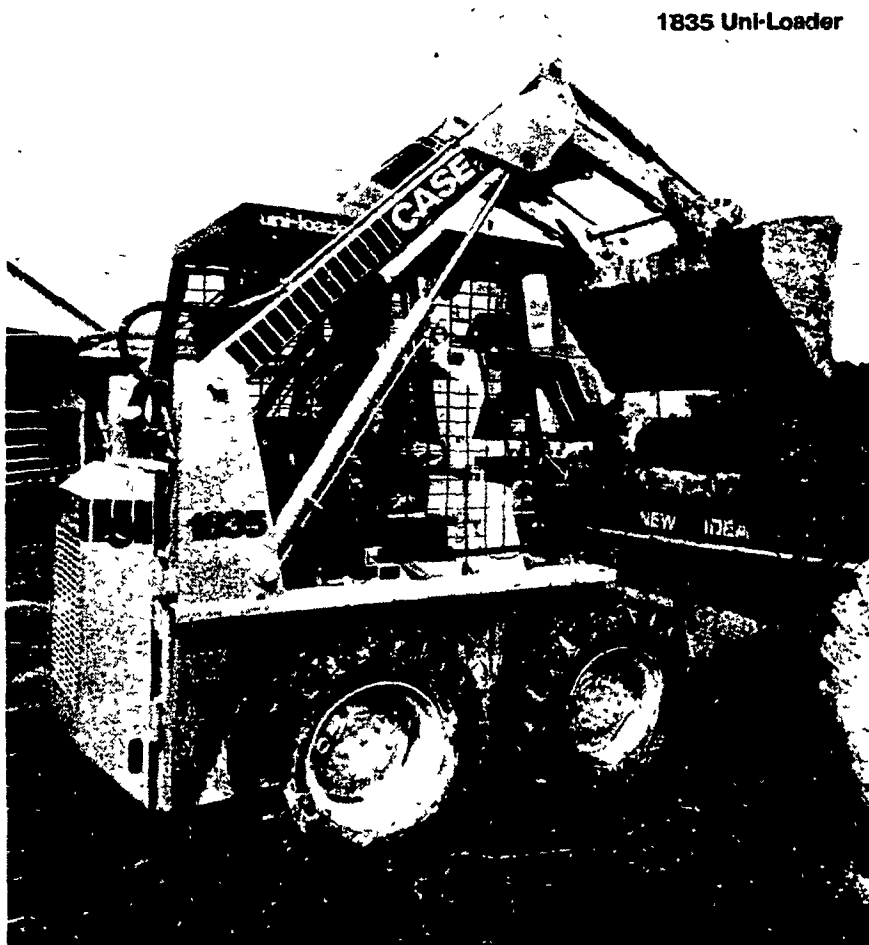

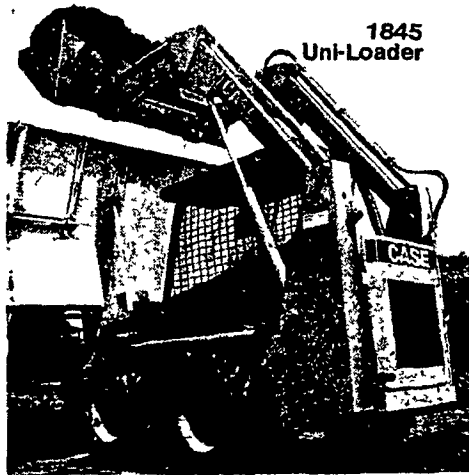
