


Crissman, Inc., Castanea purchased the grand champion lamb, a 117-pound animal also owned by Connor, for \$2.36 per pound.

The reserve champion lamb, owned by Kim Conner, was purchased by Clintondale Mills for \$1.66 per pound.









Rounding out his winning streak, Connor showed the 237pound grand champion market hog which sold to Dr. William Edwards for \$4 a pound.
