The Almanac tells how to make a gingerbread house for grandchildren at Christmas; what to do if a bee flies into your car; and how to be sure wood stoves are safe.

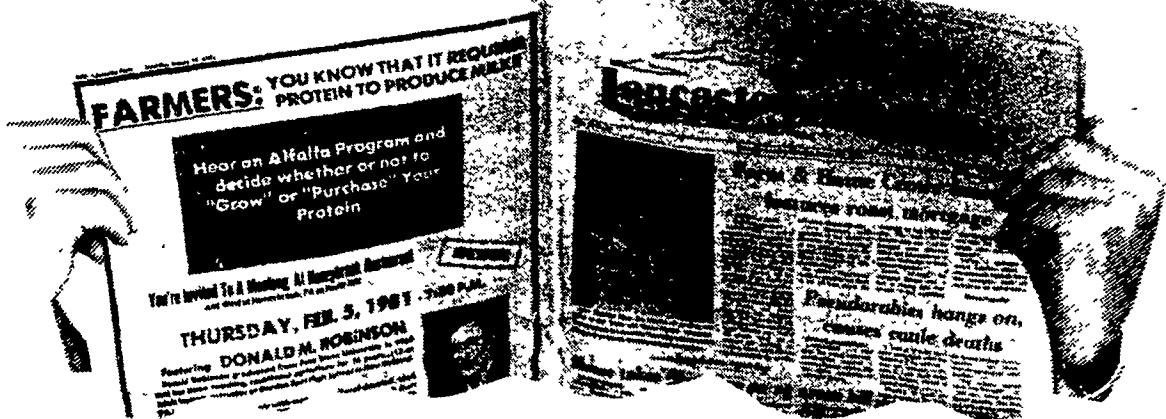
