

# Bear license mailings set for Oct.

HARRISBURG — the envelope in which Successful applicants for 1981 Pennsylvania bear hunting licenses should receive their licenses late in October, under a schedule established by the Game Commission. All applications for bear licenses must be received by the Game Commission no later than September 25. A drawing will be held September 28 to select the recipients of the license, and processing of the applications will begin immediately. Applications not selected in the drawing will be returned to the unsuccessful applicants as soon as possible after September 28. If one bear license application under any scheduled, bear licenses should be mailed on October 26. Most of those who have applied thus far have correctly filled out

the applications have been submitted. The most common errors have been failure to indicate how many applications the envelope contains, and/or failure to indicate if the entry is from a resident or nonresident. These applications are being returned so the error(s) can be corrected. This will be the first year a bear license is required to hunt bears in the Keystone State. The Game Commission has authorized the sale of 125,000 bear licenses in 1981, in an effort to control the size of the harvest. A hunter may file only one application under any circumstances; no one may apply for an "individual" license and also be in a group applying for "group" licenses. Up to 15 per-

sons may apply for "group" licenses. Hunting license issuing agents have applications, along with the required red and blue envelopes. Applications are not being handed out routinely; hunters must ask for them. A person must have a regular hunting license before filing a bear license application, since the hunting license number must be put on the bear license application. Bear license applications consist of two parts. Each applicant, regardless of whether an "individual" license or "group" licenses are being sought, must fill out the first section of the application. The second section of the application is to be filled out only by those who are applying for "group" bear licenses. The second section should be torn off and discarded if an "individual" license is sought.

A party of hunters applying for "group" bear licenses must be composed entirely of either resident or non-resident hunters. "Group" bear licenses will not be awarded to a party composed of both resident and nonresident hunters.

The applicant should be sure to include the blue return envelope, along with the application and remittance, in the red envelope.

The information required on the front of the red envelope must be filled in properly, or the application(s) will be rejected.

Applicants are reminded of the U.S. Postal Service requirement that first class postage must be on the red envelope for each application enclosed, and on the blue return envelope that will be used to mail the license(s) to the successful applicant(s), or to return the application(s) not selected in the drawing.

The blue return envelope must be addressed to the hunter by the applicant. In the case of applications for "group" licenses, the licenses will all be sent to the one applicant whose name and address appears on the blue return envelope.

Resident bear licenses cost \$5.00 each; the fee for a non-resident bear license is \$15.00.

Bear license recipients will be selected in the drawing which is open to the public and begins at 10:30 a.m. on Monday, September 28, at the Game Commission's headquarters, 8000 Derry Street, Harrisburg.
