

Md. teens take honors in horse show

COLLEGE PARK, Md. — Anne Arundel and Baltimore County teen-agers continued their strong showing in this year's senior Western 4-H horse and pony show, held Sunday, August 30 at the Maryland State Fair in Timonium.

Cindy Gertz, 18, of Crownsville, Anne Arundel County, was back winning top honors with her seven-year-old Quarter horse gelding, Clark's Joker, for the third consecutive year, while D. Joy Tice, 14, of Harwood, Anne Arundel County, continued her winning ways from junior Western competition in previous years with Bobalots, a six-year-old Quarter horse mare.

Bonnie Connelly, 18, of Dundalk, Baltimore County, won top honors in senior grooming and showmanship, as well as three first-place finishes in the Western performance classes with Kakit's Sacajawea.

Andrea Tauraso, 17, of Frederick, Frederick County, was this year's recipient of the Linda C.

Baron memorial trophy, given annually since 1977 to the winner of the senior Western horsemanship class. The plaque is sponsored by the Perry Hall 4-H Horse and Pony Club of Baltimore County in memory of a deceased member who was outstanding in both horsemanship and sportsmanship.

Andrea and her horse, Dee's Turp Lady, also placed first in one Western performance class and second in another.

Laurie Ogonowski, 14, of Northeast, Cecil County, and her P.O.A. mare, Lonesome Victory, won higher honors this year in senior Western performance than they did last year in junior competition. They were first in pole-bending for ponies, second in the barrel race, and second in the keyhole race.

A southern Maryland contestant, Kristin Tracy, and her steed, Coca Poco, took first in pole-bending for horses. Kristin lives at the Patuxent Naval Air Test Center in St. Marys County. She and her

horse were third in the third barrel race.

Wendy Young of Churchville, Harford County, and her steed, Cloudy Sunrise, placed first both in the barrel race and keyhole race for ponies.

Sandy Harvey, 18, of Swanton,

Garrett County, repeated her 1980 victory in the senior stock seat class with Eddies Dust.

Ricky Foltz of Manchester, Carroll County, and his steed, Last Chance, took first place in the knee-hole race for horses and

second in the barrel race. Ricky also placed second in senior reining with Storm Cloud.

Michael Sparks of Owings, Calvert County, and his mount, Cherokee, were first in the barrel race for horses and second in the keyhole race.

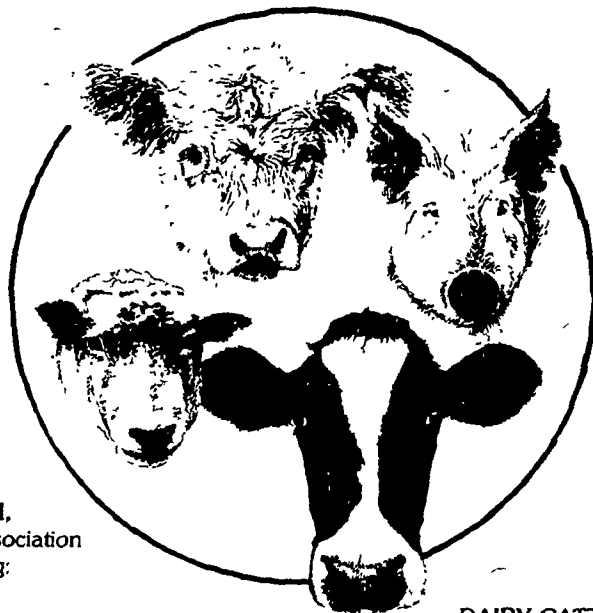
