Brian also received the Grand Champion Showman, and the Grand Champion Fitter award.



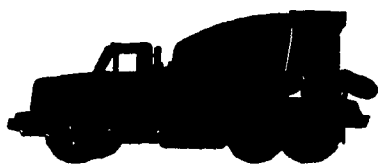

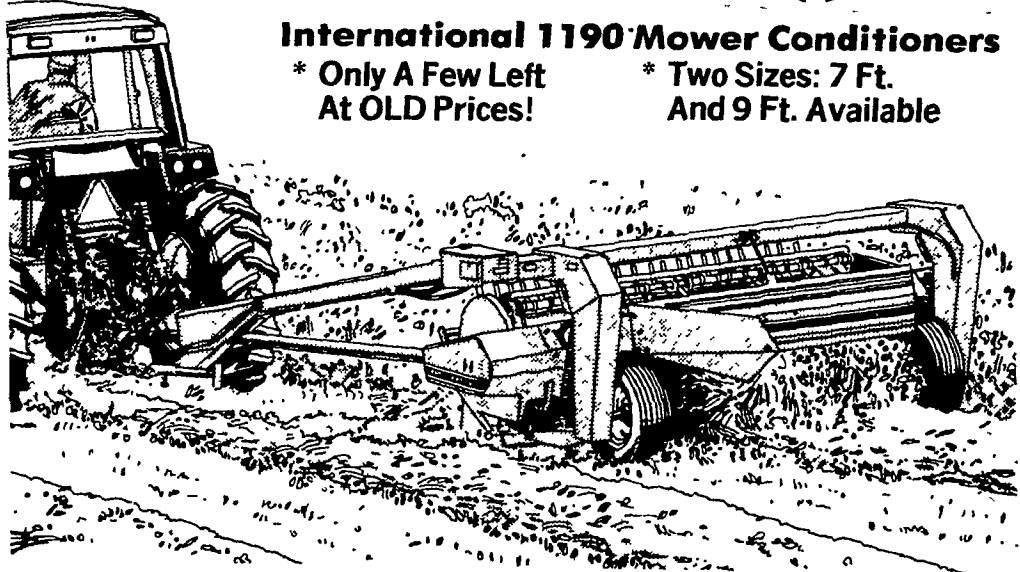
Take advantage of early results by liming in the late Summer and Fall. Get ground ready for the first Spring shoots by allowing the lime all winter to condition the soil.
