700 take part in YCC program

HARRISBURG — More than 700 youths, between the ages of 15 to 18, participated in the 1981 Youth Conservation Corps program and received personal experience in a variety of conservation-oriented projects, the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources reported today.

This year's YCC program saw a modest increase in the number of participants—725 compared to 703 during 1980 — at 70 DER-managed work sites throughout the Commonwealth.

The wide variety of projects, aimed at improving the environment on state forest and state park lands, included nature and hiking trail construction; fish and game habitat improvements; bridge maintenance, repairs and construction; and a vast array of other environmentally-oriented tasks.

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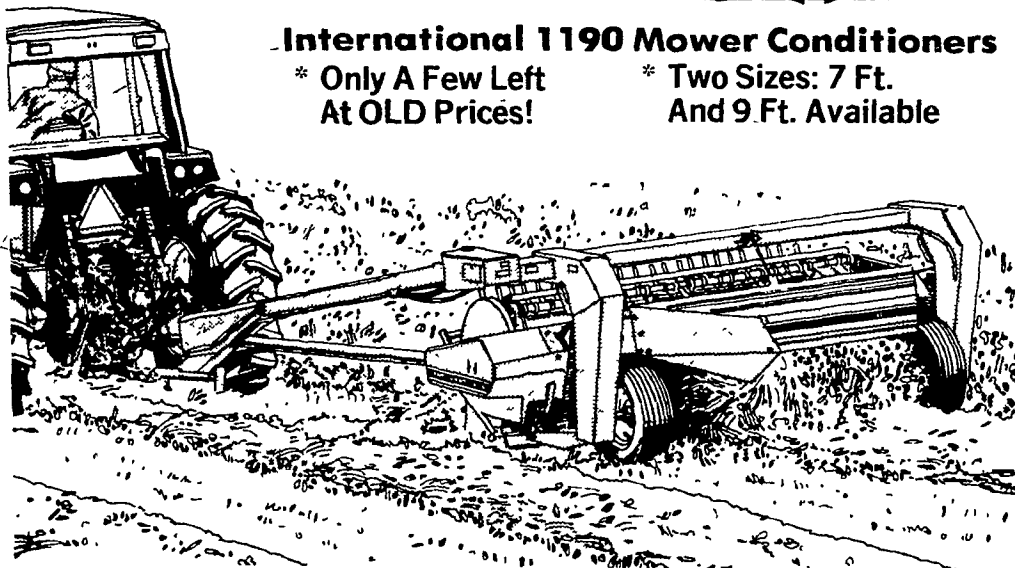
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
