Hawk Watching week coming

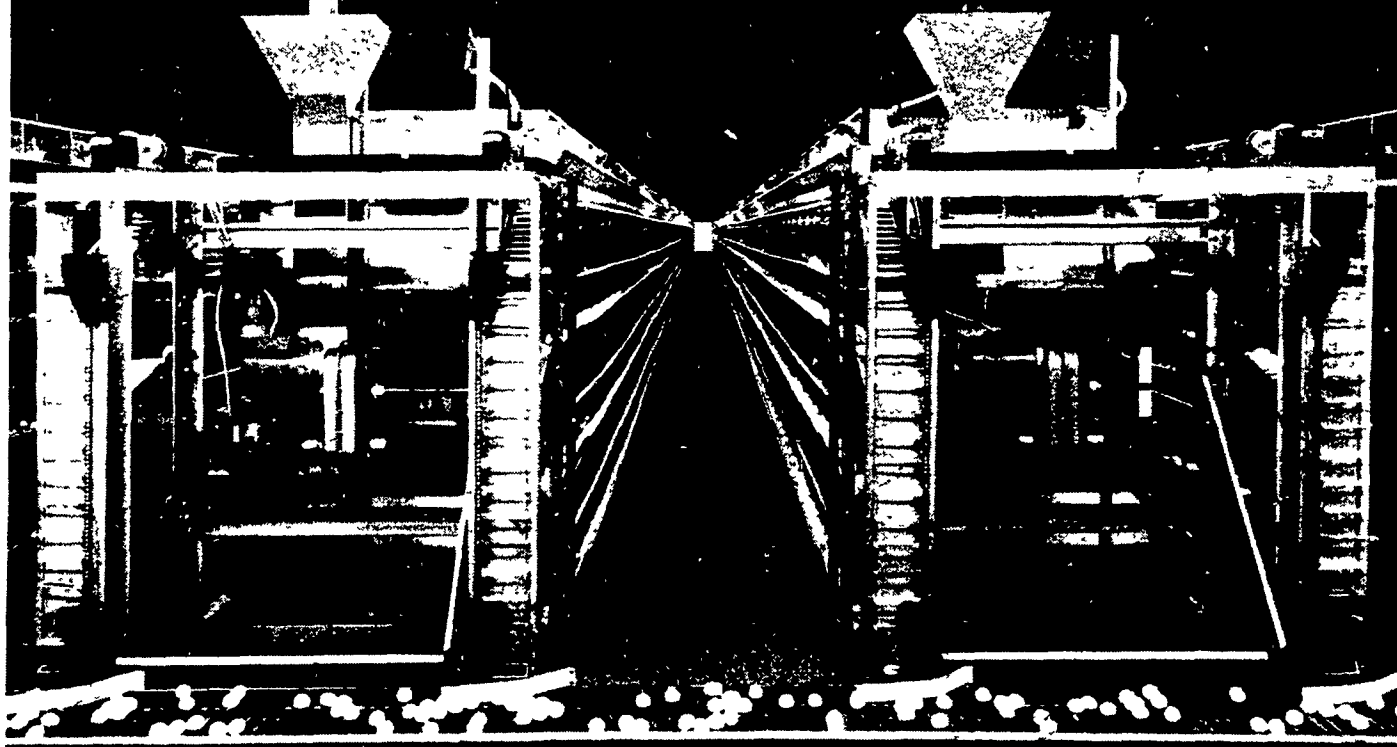
HARRISBURG — Nature lovers in Pennsylvania will be observing Hawk Watching Week October 4-10.

Hawk watching is becoming an increasingly popular activity in the Keystone State and is a major tourist attraction. Pennsylvania has some of the world's best hawk migration outlooks, and the state has become a focal point for hawk watching.

Annual autumn hawk migrations give citizens an opportunity to observe and photograph the magnificent birds. Bake Oven Knob, Hawk Mountain and other Pennsylvania mountains have become popular meccas for bird watching enthusiasts.

The Game Commission has designated nearly 150 miles of the Kittatinny Ridge mountaintop as the Kittatinny Birds of Prey Natural Area, and the agency encourages Pennsylvanians to devote additional attention to raptors during Hawk Watching Week.

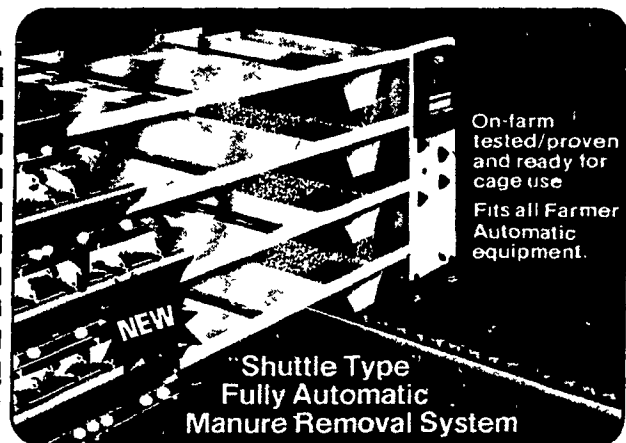

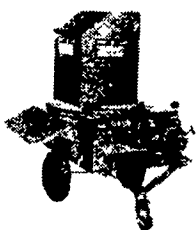
