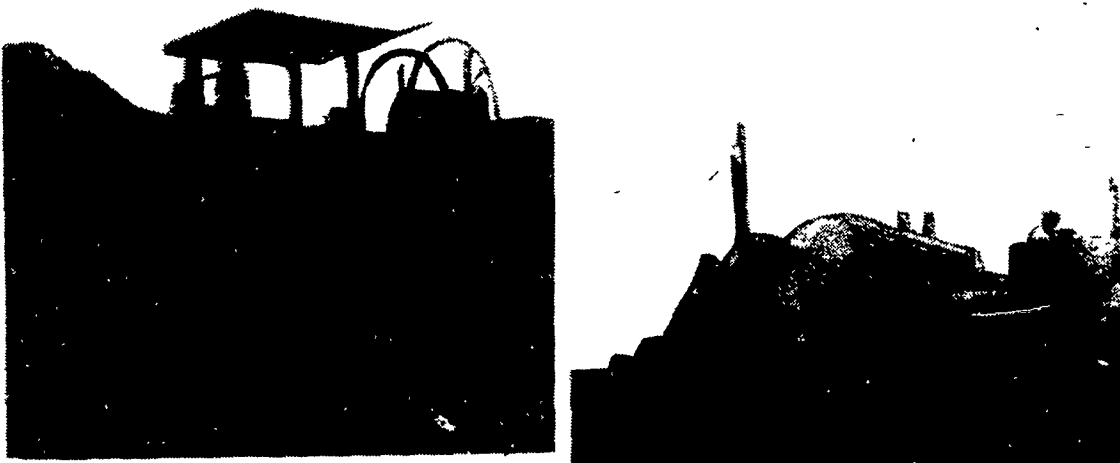

Penn State expanding farm

LANDISVILLE — Penn State's Southeast Field Research Laboratory is purchasing 18 acres and expanding its test plot facilities in Lancaster County.

In addition to the extra land, the purchase will also provide much-needed irrigation water for times when lack of rainfall affects the

crop growing tests, according to John Yocum, superintendent. The 18 acres are being purchased with federal funds for \$115,000 from Gary L. and Mary E. Longenecker, of Rapho Township.

Present size of the research farm in northwestern Lancaster County is 88 acres.
