

# Workshop features dairy feeding program

TOWANDA — Dairy specialists have often said that feeding dairy cattle was an art and science.

Beginning early next month, dairy farmers can learn more about the science by attending a series of workshops in Bradford county.

The five-day program will cover: feeding forages; feeding

concentrates; feeding programs and problems; dollars and sense in feeding; developing a feeding program for your herd.

Instructors Jacob Guffey, Bradford County dairy agent and Lehan Power, Regional Farm Management agent will offer the

feeding and management school in two locations.

The Troy High School Ag Room will be the site of one program beginning on October 6 and continuing on Oct. 13, 20, 27 and November 5.

Wyalusing High School Ag Room

will serve as the second location beginning Oct. 8 and continuing Oct. 15, 22, 29 and Nov. 2. Each session runs from 8 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

Participants are required to have a Penn State forage tests on all forages fed which costs \$18 per forage. Sampling kits will be available Oct. 6 and 8.

The cost of the program is \$3 plus forage testing kits. Pre-registrations, due now at the Bradford County Extension Office, will be limited. Participants are asked to indicate choice of location.

Guffey suggests bringing a small calculator and pencil. Refreshments will be provided.

SYRACUSE, N.Y. — Robert S. Turner, of Horseheads, N.Y., general manager of American Dairy Association and Dairy Council, Inc., Syracuse, died Thursday, September 17, in Syracuse.

Turner worked at the local, state and national levels in milk promotion for the past 20 years.

He served from 1967-1979 as member of the Board of Directors of the national American Dairy Association, serving as president of the national ADA between 1970 and 1977.

Turner was a charter member of the Board of Directors of United Dairy Industry Association founded in 1971 to unite promotion, research and nutrition education for the dairy industry.

He became general manager of the ADA&DC in 1977, directing operations of the farmer funded and directed milk promotion association serving the 22,000 dairy farmers in New York, and parts of New Jersey and Pennsylvania.

He was past president of the New York State Association of Agricultural Societies, a member of the New York State Fair Advisory Board, and also member of the Grange, the Farm Bureau, the Kiwanis and the Masons. Turner was secretary of the Chemung County Fair and served on the Horseheads School Board.

Turner, 58, of Horseheads, N.Y., is survived by his wife, Lucille, Horseheads, and two daughters, Beth, a student at RIT, Rochester and Barbara Noll and son-in-law Stephen Noll of Damascus, Maryland.
