

Archery deer season opens Oct. 3

HARRISBURG — The first of Pennsylvania's 1981-82 big game hunting seasons gets underway next Saturday, when archers begin hunting whitetail deer one half hour before sunrise.

Almost one fourth of the nation's archery hunters purchase licenses in Pennsylvania. Last year, a record 267,291 archery licenses were sold, an increase of about 15,000 over the preceding year.

During the 1980-81 seasons, archers reported harvesting 5,879 Pennsylvania deer and the Keystone State again has a large herd of whitetails this year.

There will be 24 hunting days during the regular statewide archery deer season which closes on Friday, Oct. 30. An extended 7-day season will run from Dec. 26 through Jan. 2. Hunting hours are from one half hour before sunrise until sunset. Sunday hunting is prohibited.

Use of bow and arrow is also permitted during the regular antlered and antlerless seasons in November and December.

Archers may take one deer of either sex, regardless of size. If a deer is tagged during the archery season, the hunter is not permitted to take another whitetail during the regular gunning season.

In addition to a regular resident or nonresident hunting license, an archery license is required to hunt deer with bow and arrow during the archery seasons. Archery licenses are available, at \$2.20, from county treasurers, most issuing agents, or by mail from the Pennsylvania Game Commission, License Section, P.O. Box 1567, Harrisburg, PA 17120.

Archers are reminded by the Game Commission that mechanical bow releases remain unlawful. Arrows must be of a cutting-edge broadhead design for big game and turkey. Deer must be tagged immediately, and the big game report card mailed to the Game Commission within five days after harvest.
