Champion in the Western Pony division is Steve Sterling, of Smyrna. Reserve champion is Dale Jarman, Camden-Wyoming.

In the English Pleasure Pony division, the championship goes to Karen Horeis, Felton. Janette Armstrong, Wilmington, takes the reserve championship. English Pleasure Horse champion is Jody Steele, of Dover. Joan Edwards, of Dover, is reserve champion.

Ginger Aikens of Milton is champion in the Western Pleasure Horse division of the 4-H Horse Show.




