The New York Beef Cattlemen's Association has endorsed the special preconditioned calf sale as part of its emphasis on marketing and has adopted a series of guidelines for preconditioning feeder calves.

These guidelines include

days prior to the sale date. The weaned calves are to be eating roughage from a feed bunk and than a natural source (ponds, streams, etc.) Calves are to be castrated and dehorned at least 30 days before the sale and are to be

weaning calves not less than 30 treated for grubs. Calves are to be vaccinated against stress diseases and respiratory infections.

Each calf consigned to the drinking water from a source other Dryden sale is to be accompanied with a certificate from a veterinarian stating guidelines have been met.


Association will also sponsor its regular fall feeder calf sales and each sponsoring division will make its own provisions to handle preconditioned calves consigned to its sale.






