

Indiana entries top feeder calf show at KILE

HARRISBURG — Mike & Pat Barker of Kendallville, Indiana, showed the grand champion feeder calf pen of the show last Friday during the Keystone International Livestock Exposition, this week at the Farm Show Complex. The Barker's winning pen of Chianina-Angus crossbreeds took the championship title in the

feeder steer competition, and were the first place crossbred pen. The Barker brothers also exhibited the champion single feeder calf, while of Airville showed the reserve champion single feeder calf. The reserve grand champion pen of show went to the second place crossbred pen of steers owned by

Don E. Johnson of Lewisburg, West Virginia. Johnson's pen followed the grand champion in the feeder steer championships as well. In the pen of five feeder heifers, crossbreeds shown by Stornoway Farms of Lagonier, Westmoreland County, won the grand champion title. Show judge was A.L. Eller, Jr. of Blacksburg, Virginia.
