Hunters get goose blinds

HARRISBURG — Reservations have been made by the Pennsylvania Game Commission for 1,950 lucky goose hunters at the Pymatuning and Middle Creek Wildlife Management Area this year.

Names of 1,000 hunters were drawn for the Pymatuning Area in Crawford County from 24,284 applications submitted. Another 950 names were drawn for the Middle Creek Area in Lebanon and Lancaster Counties from 12,700 applications submitted.

The first applications drawn at Middle Creek were those of Bryan D. Jenks of Lancaster, Alfred L. Beslanovits of Copley, Thomas J. Wardle of Jamison, George A. Filepas of Harrisburg and Merle D. Stremmel of Hanover. The first woman's application drawn was that of Susan L. Kaylor of Lewisburg, and the first nonresident's application drawn was that of Dennis L. Boatman of Edgewater, Maryland.

At Pymatuning, the first applications drawn were those of Dennis P. Bresnehand of Chicora, Donald W. Updegraff of Greensburg, Darryl Butt of Warren, P. Samuel Young of Transfer and Edwin Vesley of East Hickory. The first woman's application drawn was that of Helen A. Stierer of Pittsburgh, and the first nonresident's application drawn was that of George Clontz of Tonawanda, New York.

Both drawings were conducted before overflow crowds of interested sportsmen and sportswomen.

Shooting begins at Pymatuning on October 10 and ends on November 30, while shooting at Middle Creek begins October 19 and ends on December 24.
