

Local breeders take Chianina championships

HARRISBURG — Three of the four grand champion plaques in Monday's Chianina show at the Keystone International Livestock Exposition went to local breeders. In the female competition,

Dwayne Messick of Elizabethtown led his April 1980 heifer to the top of her class before being tagged by Judge Gary Minish of VPI as senior and grand champion heifer. Messick's heifer, dubbed Blue

Sky Princess 11480, is a Blue Sky Jet Set daughter out of TOF Miss Dolly 5758.

A half-sister to the grand champion, Jet Set's Candy Girl, was exhibited by Messick in the

first class of Chianina heifer calves. This April 1981 heifer stood second. Messick's junior bull entry, MF Mr. Starmaker, a Friggio son, placed second to neighboring Joseph Messick's MF Jet Set's Dynamo. Dynamo went on to be tagged junior champion before taking the grand championship of the Chianina competition.

The grand champion bull is a Blue Sky Jet Set son out of Ms Lombard Lauxmont A724. Joseph Messick is a young cattleman from Middletown, Dauphin County. He also exhibited the reserve senior champion heifer, MF Jet Sets Fancy, an April 1980 heifer by Blue Sky Jet Set.

Still another Dauphin County Chianina breeder claimed one of the championships at Monday's show. James Foreman, Hershey, showed his October 1980 bull to the calf championship and on to reserve grand honors. Foreman's Berney is an Advance Copy son out of Foreman's Miss Chocolate.

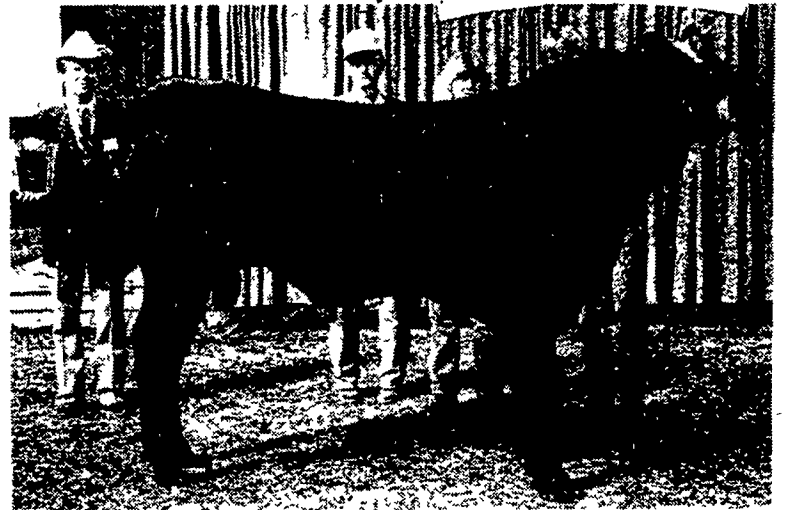
