

Maryland 4-H'er wins in nat'l dairy judging

BALTIMORE, Md. — Another Maryland County resident has won top honors in national 4-H dairy cattle judging competition.

This year's winner is Michael J. Allen, 18, of Jefferson, an animal science sophomore at the University of Maryland in College Park. Ronnie Kling of Taneytown, Maryland, won in 1974.

Mike placed first in over-all individual standings as well as total reasons.

In addition, he was first in Jersey breed judging and second in Ayrshire judging. His feat earned him the annual \$500 Lawrence O. Colebank Guernsey scholarship award.

The Maryland 4-H team finished eleventh among 37 state teams in

this year's national contest. The team placed third in total reasons, second in Jersey and Holstein breed judging, and tenth in Guernsey judging.

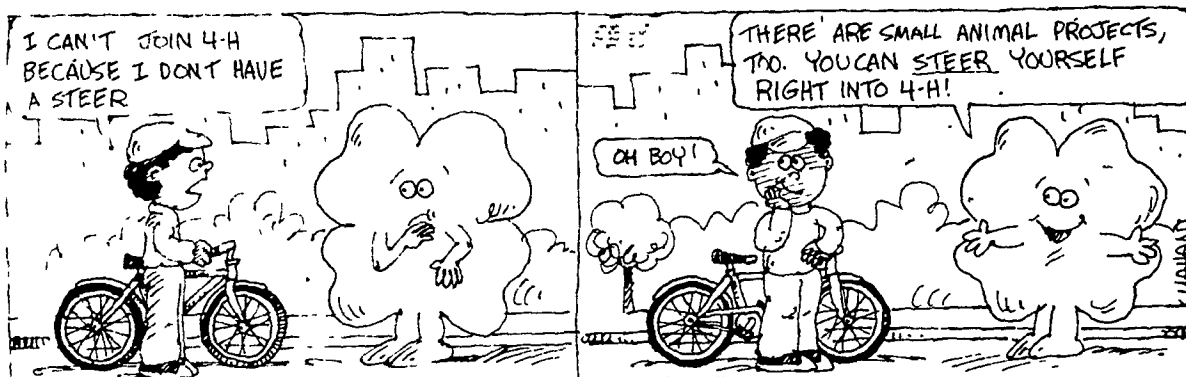

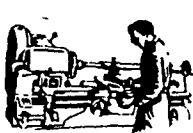
