

Bradford-Sullivan farmers hold annual meeting

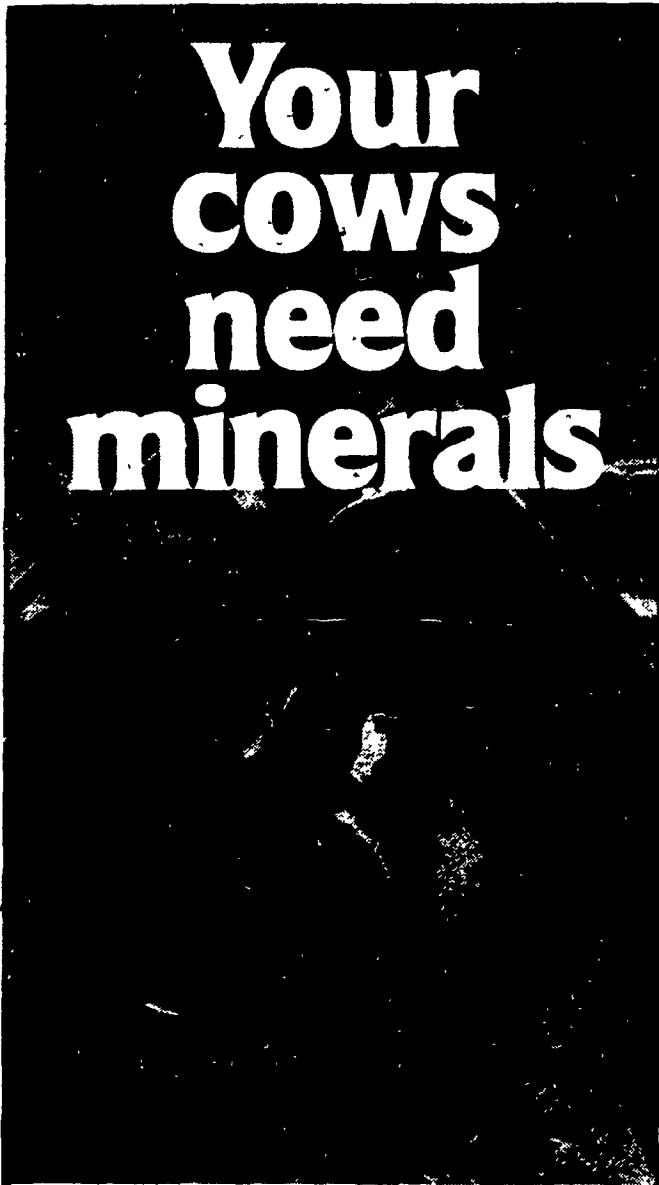

WYSOX — Paul Mazza, attorney for the Pennsylvania Farmers' Association Legal Service, was featured speaker at the annual dinner meeting of the Bradford-

Sullivan County Farmers' Association held in the Wysox Fire Hall recently. Mazza explained estate planning and the 1981 Tax Act to a record crowd of nearly 200 people. Careful estate planning is still

the key to keeping the farm in the family, Mazza emphasized, although some features of the new tax act are beneficial to the farm family. The unlimited marital deduction or repeal of the widow's tax is a great boon and a direct

result of the work of many women working together in the United States to get this law passed. Formerly the work farm women contributed to the estate was not recognized as having any dollar value.

The additional gift tax provisions raised from \$3,000 per year will be raised to \$10,000, and improvements in payments of inheritance taxes were discussed briefly. (Turn to Page A39)

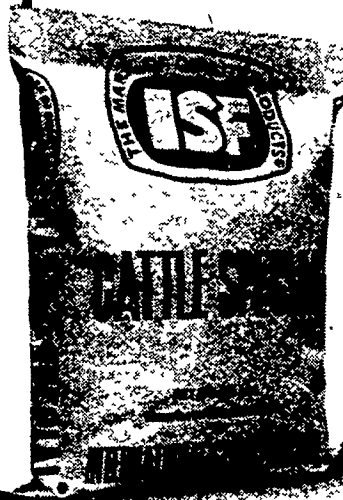

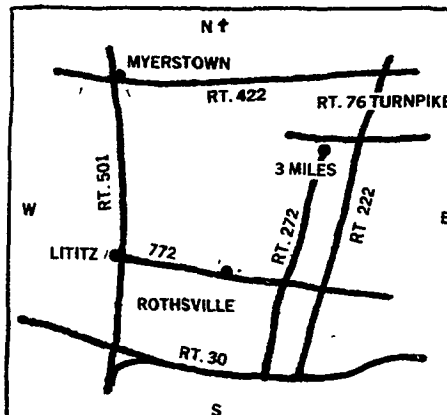
