
Charolais champs excel in Eastern National

TIMONIUM, Md. - Charolais breeders called the Eastern National competition the Role of Excellence Show. And by the contest's end, Thursday, the three judges left no doubt that what they evaluated was nothing short of excellence.

'The quality ran very deep,' said Jim Gillooly, an Angus and Hereford breeder from Washington, Indiana.

Gillooly also lauded the entries for their uselfulness as did second iudge Donald Bauman, a Charolais breeder from Carpenter Wyoming.

"What I've seen today has been good for the breed and good for the beef industry," Bauman commented.

Third judge Gordon Schubert, a Chianina breeder from The Plains, Virginia, said he felt gains in the Charolais breed might benifit other breeds, as well.

"I thank the Charolais breed for waking some of us other breeders up," Schubert said.

The three men scrutinized more than 60 enteries from ten states.

Miss JXN Junior 13M, their choice for grand champion heifer continued her perfect unbeaten record this season. The Poker King Jr. daughter, a spring yearling was the entry of R and W Farms, Stone-Del Farms and Thorpes T.B.S. Charolais, Hartville, Ohio.

The top bull of the day, RCC Royal Standout 2973, scored his first big win of the season. The summer senior yearling is owned by Barton Charolais Ranches and Royal Charolais Company, Abbeville, South Carolina.

Junior Champion Female honors went to Miss CCC Omens Empress, a winter calf owned by Duncan Charolais Farm and Bobby Davis Custom Fitters, Abbeville, S.C. The junior champ returned to the ring and was named grand champion female.

Behind her, the three judges selected Riverwood Crocus 560, a senior calf owned by Adams Charolais Farms, Springfield, Ohio.

Missouri exhibitors, Malcolm Commer, Jr. and Bayvue Farms from Bay, claimed the Calf Champion Bull title with their winter calf Rembrandt.

The judges went with Doris Bell's senior calf, CCC Havoc's Superman 0899 for reserve calf champion bull. The Cooksville, Md. exhibitor's reserve champ is sired by Riverwood Havoc 1907.

Junior Champion Bull honors went to Sir Stone-Del King Jr. 019 owned by Stone-Del Farms, Cramblett Charolais and Olentangy Farms, Carrollton, Ohio. The spring yearling later went on to be named reserve grand

Two Pennsylvania bulls took home champion rosettes before the day ended. JC Kruger 035, a summer yearling owned by J.C. Enterprises, Ringold, was tapped as reserve junior champion bull.

Royal Charolais Company of Greensburg, claimed the Reserve Senior Bull title with their summer senior yearling, RCC Royal Constructor.




