FCM is a method devised for converting yields to a 3.5% fat-corrected-milk. FCM allows the comparison of milk production records, varying widely in percentage of butterfat and thus differing in energy value.

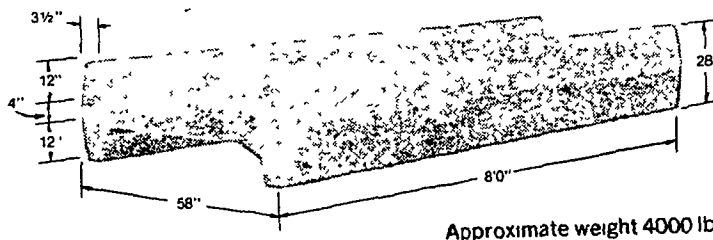
