

Area 2 turkey season extended

HARRISBURG — The Pennsylvania Game Commission has extended the fall turkey hunting season by one week in Management Area No. 2. This means that most of the state will have a three-week season.

Management Area 2 is a Y-shaped part of the Commonwealth embracing southcentral, northeastern and a large portion of northwestern Pennsylvania. Originally, a two-week season was scheduled for Areas 2 and 3, with a three-week season in Area 1.

Now, the turkey season will open statewide today and conclude on November 21, except in extreme western and southeastern sections, where the season will close on November 14.

Brood counts this year show an increase in poult production in Area 2, and district game protectors report the best turkey hunting will take place in south-central and northeastern parts of the state.

Turkey Management Areas 1, 2 and 3 are described on the chart.

UNIVERSITY PARK — Michael D. Orzolek has been appointed to Penn State's Cooperative Extension Service faculty as vegetable specialist.

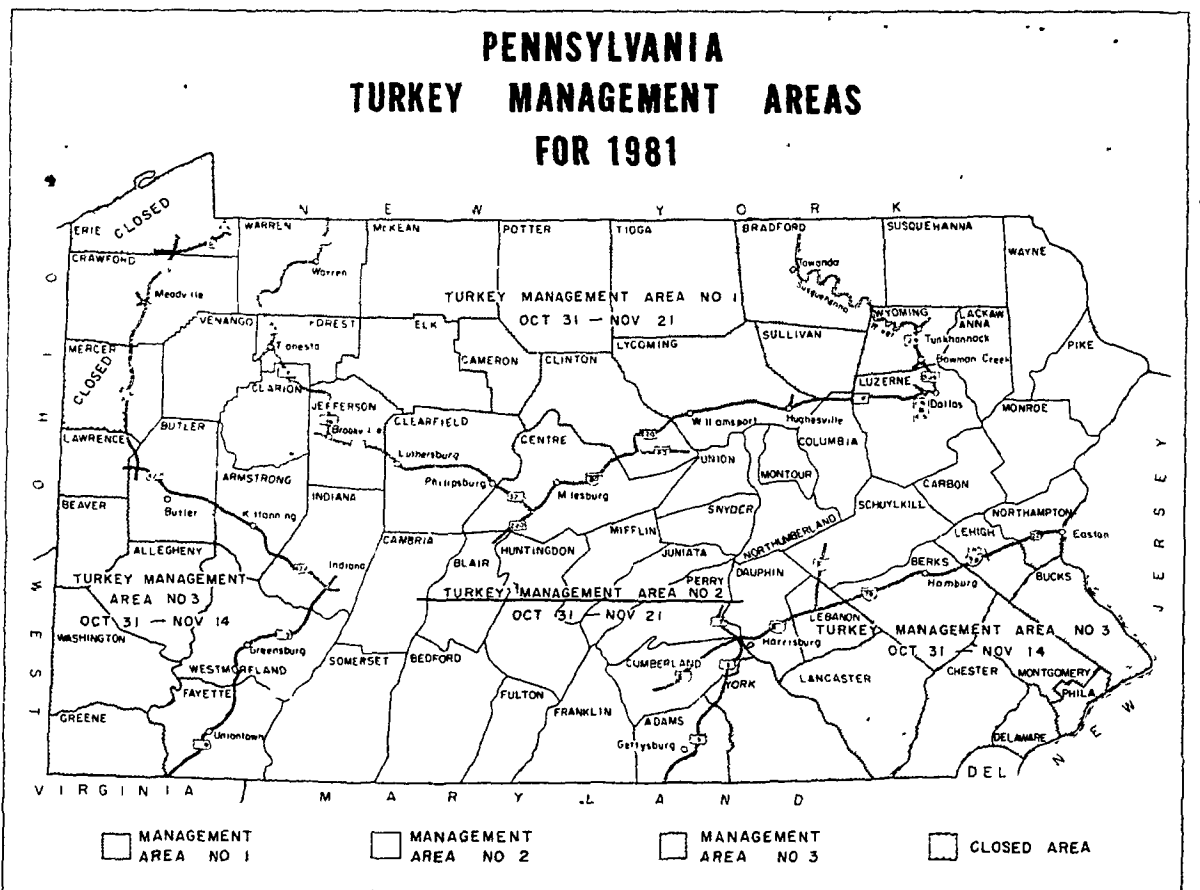

A native of Watertown, New York, he received a bachelor of science degree in biology from

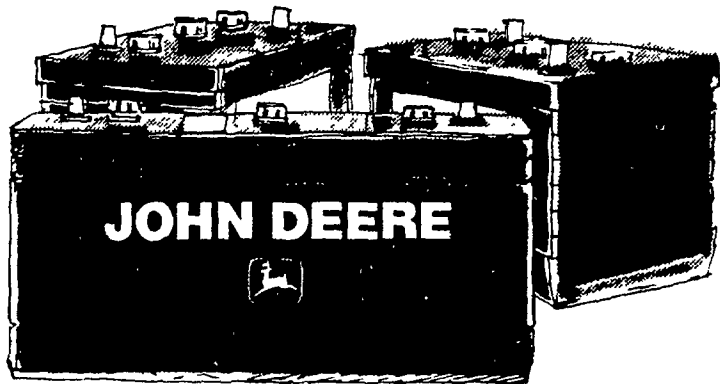
Alliance College; master of science degree in horticulture from West Virginia University; and doctor of philosophy degree in horticulture from the University of Maryland.

He is a member of the American Society for Horticultural Sciences.

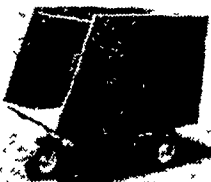

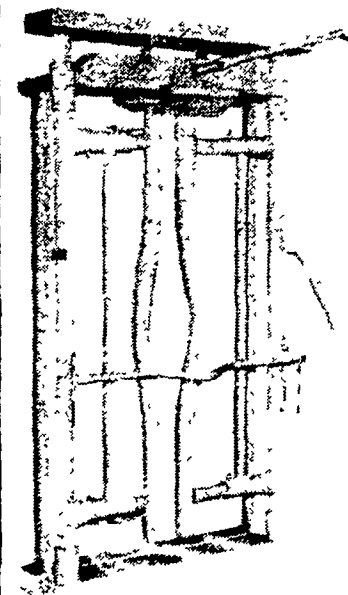
