

## N.Y. livestock dealer is fined \$12,000

NEW YORK, N.Y. — Gilbert Kapp, New Berlin, N.Y., has been fined \$12,000 by the U.S. District Court in Syracuse, and permanently enjoined from operating as a livestock dealer without furnishing a bond as required by the U.S. Department of

### Agriculture.

Kapp, registered with USDA as a dealer to buy and sell livestock in commerce, operates in central New York.

B.H. (Bill) Jones, P&S administrator in Washington, D.C., said the P&S Act requires that livestock dealers and market

agencies furnish a valid bond to secure their livestock obligations.

The P&S Act is a fair trade practices law administered by the Packers and Stockyards Administration. It promotes fair and open competition in the marketing of livestock, meat and poultry.

Thirty six female lots sold for an average of \$596.78, five bull lots an average of \$564 and eight steer lots of an average of \$328.12.

On the agenda will be an evaluation discussion of the sale, with finalization of the Mason-Dixon Association activities for the next year.
